PORT ADELAIDE, SEMAPHORE ANCHORAGE.

Leading Lights.

Referring to Notice No. 12 of 1888, as to the removal of the Beatrice, mariners are now hereby informed that, on and after December 1, 1888, two red lights will be exhibited ashore, one from the Timeball tower and the other from the flagstaff at the shore end of Semaphore jetty.

These lights in line, bearing S.E. ¼ S., lead through the deepest water in the Semaphore anchorage, and up to the Ocean Steamers' mooring buoy.

Directions.

By night.—Vessels approaching the anchorage should not bring the Port Adelaide light to the North of N.E.

until the above lights are in line, then steer in on that line with the lead going until the requisite water is found or the mooring buoy is picked up. When the red light, east of the lighthouse, is just closing with the bright light on No. 11 beacon, the vessel will be close to the mooring buoy.

The leading lights will not show south of the bell buoy on the Wonga shoal, so that vessels of suitable draught, which do not intend to use the mooring buoy, may steer in for any part of the anchorage as soon as the two red lights are visible.

By day.—Keep the lighthouse on the same bearing until the Timeball tower and the Water tower are in line, then proceed as above.

SHIRAKAMI-SAKI LIGHTHOUSE.

Fog Signal.

Notice is hereby given that an air siren, worked by a calorific engine, has been erected at Shirakami-saki lighthouse, western entrance to Tsugaru Straits, and will be sounded during foggy or thick weather at the rate of one blast per minute, the sound of which will be of 4 seconds' duration, and in calm weather should be heard at a distance of about 4 miles.

If from any accident the siren cannot be sounded, a hand siren will be sounded at the rate of one blast per minute with intervals of 5 minutes after every 10 minutes' working.

MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, December 14, 1888.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M. pursuant to notice dated December 8, 1888.

Present:—Mr. H. H. Cameron, Mayor and Chairman; the Hon. Lt.-Col. F. C. H. Clarke, B.A., C.M.G.; Mr. R. K. MacBride; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; the Hon. J. J. Grinlinton; Mr. C. E. H. Symons; Mr. E. Walker; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; and Mr. H. Van Cuylenburg.

Read Minutes of December 11, 1888, which were confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Mr. Walker asked "if any reply has been received from Government with reference to the resolution of July 13, 1888, regarding the issue of liquor licenses."

The Chairman stated that no reply had been received, and that attention had been called to the matter.

2. Pursuant to notice Mr. Walker asked "if any reply has been received from Messrs. Freudenberg and Co. in connection with the tramway concessions granted to them."

The Chairman explained that Messrs. Freudenberg & Co. had accepted the concessions, and that having requested that the Council would arrange to have them legally executed in their favour, Mr. De Saram had been asked to prepare a draft agreement.

Read, in connection with the above, a letter dated November 19, 1888, from Mr. De Saram, submitting the draft agreement, and also a letter dated November 27 from Mr. Advocate Dornhorst, suggesting a doubt as to the powers of the Municipal Council to be a party to the agreement, and stating that the Attorney-General, with whom he had an interview on the subject, promised to look into the matter and communicate his views.

It was thereupon resolved that a copy of Mr. Dornhorst's opinion be forwarded to Government, with a request that the Attorney-General might be consulted before the agreement was perfected.

3. Pursuant to notice Mr. Walker asked "whether any reply has been received from the Inspector-General of Police bearing upon the resolution of Council requesting the institution of a test case in connection with houses of ill-fame, and, if so, that it be read."

The Chairman stated that a reply had been received.

Read the reply (No. 5,085 of December 10, 1888) referred to, intimating that the case fell through, because the Solicitor-General considered that the facts were not sufficient to support a prosecution; and that in view of the conditions necessary, in the Solicitor-General's opinion, to sustain a prosecution, it would be seldom possible "to successfully prosecute brothels merely as such."

4. Pursuant to notice Mr. Walker moved "that in view of the failure of the test case instituted in accordance with the resolution passed at the last Ordinary Meeting relating to houses of ill-fame, this Council now moves that the Government may be pleased to pass an Ordinance, either embodying section 30 of the Madras Police Act VIII. of 1867, or so framed that this Council may be in a position to deal with the evil in question, which is now assuming alarming proportions. The Madras Act runs as follows:—

"On proof to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Police, or of a Magistrate, that a house is used as a common brothel or lodging house for prostitutes or disorderly persons of any description, to the annoyance of the respectable inhabitants of the vicinity, such Commissioner or Magistrate may summon the owner or tenant of the house to answer the complaint, and on being satisfied that the house is so used, and is therefore a source of annoyance and offence to the neighbours, may order the owner or tenant to discontinue such use of it; and if he shall fail to comply with such order within five days, may impose upon him a fine to the extent of twenty-five rupees for every day thereafter that the house shall be so used."

The Chairman having pointed out that when the above section of the Madras Act was before the Council on July 13, 1888, it was resolved that the words "or to the public" be added after "neighbours," Mr. Walker agreed to the addition of the words referred to.

Mr. Van Cuylenburg seconded.—Carried.

5. The Chairman intimated that the following motion, of which notice had been given by Mr. Coomaraswamy, was withdrawn:—"That the letter No. 4,897 from the Inspector-General of Police be considered, and that this Council do take steps to have the Police Detective Force of Colombo increased."

6. Pursuant to notice Mr. Van Cuylenburg, for Mr. Seneviratna, moved "that the letter of the Secretary of the Non-descript Cricket Club be considered."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.

Read letter dated December 10 from Mr. V. Van Langenberg, Honorary Secretary of the Non-descript Cricket Club, applying for the exclusive use of a piece of land in the Cinnamon Gardens for purposes of cricket.

Mr. Van Cuylenburg moved that application be made to Government to vest in the Council the piece of land opposite the Baptist Chapel, in the Cinnamon Gardens, to be used as a recreation ground by cricket and other clubs, on payment of a fee to be hereafter determined by the Council, and that the Chairman be now authorised to allot portions of the Victoria Park to the different clubs which have made application for grounds for their exclusive use, upon terms to be fixed by the Chairman.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

7. Pursuant to notice Dr. Vanderstraaten moved "that a sum of Rs. 1,000 be voted for the immediate filling up of the St. Sebastian quarry, above water-level, and that Government be requested to allow prison labour free for this work."

This motion was, by leave of Council, withdrawn for the present.

8. Pursuant to notice Dr. Vanderstraaten moved "that By-laws be framed to regulate the washing of linen from vessels in which infectious diseases have been or are prevailing—

- (1) The Port Surgeon to give permission for clothes to be landed, or not, according to his discretion.
- (2) A canoe, kept specially licensed by dhobies, to be used for bringing the linen to the washing depot.
- (3) An old iron barge to be moored along the reclamation ground, adjoining Bankshall street, to be the "washing depot." The barge to contain—

- (1) A water tank to be filled from a water boat.
- (2) Large iron cauldrons, to contain boiling water, into which dirty linen is to be immersed in the first instance—the water to be carbolicised with carbolic acid.

- (3) The clothes to be dried on a spot reserved for this purpose.
 (4) Another site to be selected on shore for the washing of all other clothes (excepting the above) brought on shore from vessels in the harbour.
 (5) Fees to be charged to cover cost.

This motion was, by leave of Council, amended by the omission of the paragraph commencing "Another site." Mr. Girdlington seconded.—Carried.

9. Submitted the following recommendations of the Standing Committee of November 13 and 30 and December 6, 1888:—

(If engaged by the hour.)

For the first half-hour ... 25c., or 6d.

For the second half-hour ... 25c., or 6d.

For every subsequent hour or portion of an hour ... 12½c., or 3d.

Rates chargeable between 7.30 p.m. and 6 a.m. to be one-third more than the above rates.

9. Recommend that terms proposed by the Honorary Secretary, Turf Club, be accepted.

Orders.

1. Recommend that the Council do explain to Government that for want of funds the original intention of the Council, as expressed in letter of March 16, 1866, has not been carried out, but that as the Council are now in a position to reclaim this land, and as for sanitary reasons it is desirable that it should be so reclaimed, they trust the Government will not withdraw the former conditional transfer.

4. Resolved to concur with the Chairman in declaring the new meat stalls at Dhobies' pond to be a "market" in the meaning of the Ordinance 7 of 1887.

Resolved,—That the recommendations contained in the above extract be adopted.

Resolved,—That the rent of each meat stall in the new market at Dhobies' pond, referred to in paragraph 4, be fixed at Rs. 20 per mensem.

10. and 11. Submitted a Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to November 30, 1888, and a Progress Report of work done brought up to the same date.

12. Submitted the following memorandum of amendments to Ordinance 7 of 1887, proposed by the Chairman to be suggested to Government :—

Seniority of Official Councillors. This is now regulated by chapter II, 6 of the by-laws in Ordinance 16 of 1881, and seniority depends on the date of appointment in *Gazette*; but as a senior official may, in this case, have to rank after his juniors if the latter happen to have been gazetted before him, it is obvious that some provision is necessary to establish the precedence of senior officials.

Houses of ill-fame. The following, adapted from the Indian Act (Calcutta Police Act—Act IV. B. C. of 1866, section 43, and Madras Police Act No. VIII. of 1867, section 30) may be included in the amending Ordinance :—

“ On proof to the satisfaction of the Inspector-General of Police, or of the Municipal Magistrate that a house is used as a common brothel or lodging-house for prostitutes or disorderly persons of any description, such Inspector-General or Municipal Magistrate may summon the owner or tenant of the house to appear before the Municipal Magistrate, and, on being satisfied that the house is so used, and is a source of annoyance and offence to the neighbours or to the public, such magistrate may order the owner or tenant to discontinue such use of it, and if he shall fail to comply with such order within five days, may impose upon him a fine to the extent of Rs. 25 for every day thereafter that the house shall be so used.”

Metal and other quarries. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council to prohibit the further working of all metal and other quarries, and the opening up of fresh ones, within Municipal limits, except by permission of the Chairman, and on such conditions as he may impose, for the fulfilment of which it shall be lawful for such Chairman to require adequate security. (*Resolution adopted by Municipal Council on November 16, 1888.*)

Section 11 of Ordinance 7 of 1887. Qualification (c) and the last paragraph seem to be inconsistent; for residence in the division for the Councillor of which one vote is an indispensable qualification, and yet a person possessed of a house in more divisions than one has a vote for every such house of the required value. Does a voter usually reside in more than one house, even in the sense in which “reside” is interpreted in the Ordinance? This difficulty should be cleared up.

Section 46 (d) and section 160. Insert “construction of tramways” and “and construct tramways.”

Section 55. Add 14 of 1862 (Gunpowder), 1 of 1869 (Gas), 19 of 1869 (Firearms), 3 of 1871 (Gas), 12 of 1873 (Gunpowder), 22 of 1873 and 23 of 1877 (Liquor), 6 of 1876 (Poisons), 7 of 1886 (Water), 6 of 1887 (Petroleum), 15 of 1887 (Guides).

Sections 89 and 92. Section 89 requires 4 days' notice of a meeting, and 92 that no business shall be transacted at such meeting other than that specified in the notice, unless a member wishes to submit any other business, of which he must give 3 days' notice. If these numbers were transposed, the difficulty would disappear.

Section 141. The time—15 days after service of notice of assessment—allowed by Ordinance 5 of 1867 to an objector to assessment for an appeal to the courts, being insufficient to enable Council to deal with objections, such time should be extended to 3 months.

Section 143. A vehicle or animal is liable to tax if kept or used for 30 days, but no person is liable for any vehicle or animal in his possession for less than 60 days. This seems inconsistent.

Section 151. Provides sale of seized property after expiration of 8 days from day of seizure, while form of warrant E, page 62, provides sale after 5 days. This should be rectified.

Section 212. The Chairman has power to set apart places for washing animals or clothes, but does not seem to have power to prevent washing in places not set apart. This power should be supplied.

Section 276. If this section does not provide for protection of Municipal collectors, &c., who may be resisted in the execution of their duties, provision should be made to meet this defect. At present such cases of resistance are dealt with by the Police Magistrate under the Code, when they might properly be dealt with by the Municipal Magistrate.

It is desirable that the power vested in the Chairman by Ordinance 7 of 1887, of giving notice to remove buildings, &c., should be extended to all notices issued under the By-laws, where at present such notices are required to be given by the Council.

Resolved,—That the sections in the above memorandum relating to houses of ill-fame, sections 89 and 92 and section 276 of Ordinance 7 of 1887, and the last paragraph, be omitted, and that the memorandum be otherwise approved.

13. Read a letter No. 132, of November 8, 1888, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, intimating that the Governor is unable to sanction the proposal relating to a reduction of the charge for water supplied to hotels.

14. Read a letter No. 1,927, of November 29, 1888, from the Hon. the Government Agent, intimating that an offer of Rs. 545 made to the owner of an allotment of land required for the improvement of Arab lane, has been rejected, and that the matter will therefore be referred to court.

Resolved,—That the Government Agent be authorised to refer the matter to the court.

15. Submitted the Sanitary Officer's report for the third quarter of 1888.

16. Submitted the analyst's report dated November 24, 1888, of the town water for November.

17. Submitted a petition dated October 26, 1888, from Patteage Siman Peries, with reference to the lease of the Grandpass market.

Resolved,—that an extension of the lease be granted to the petitioner to December 31, 1889.
