ACCOUSED PERSONS WANTED.

VELETHANTHRIGE ABRAHAM BALIGA APPU; charged with erasing and altering certificate of character at Colombo on September 12, 1905; is a Sinhalese of the Goigama caste; occupation, appu; age, about 20 years; height, 5 ft. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ in.; make, well built; complexion, dark brown; nose, prominent; eyes, dark brown, oval, and sunken; hair, black and tied in a knot; wears slight moustaches; has a white mark on the left arm, a mole below left nipple, and vaccinated; birthplace, Kesbewa in Salpiti korale; general residence, Kollonnawa; is well known to Mr. J. J. Martins of Kotte road, Mr. W. Perry of Colpetty, and clerks of the Registrar of Servants' Office, Colombo. The Police Magistrate of Colombo has issued warrant No. 95,469 for his arrest.

YADDESSALAGE LAPAYA; charged with theft at Aramagle estate, Kegalla, on September 18, 1905; is a Sinhalese of the Oliya caste; religion, Buddhist; occupation, cultivator; age, 20 years; height, about 5 ft.; complexion, brown; nose, long; teeth, regular; eyes, round and black; hair, black, tied in a knot; wears slight moustaches; birthplace and general residence, Rahala; haunts Batawala in Galboda korale; is single; father, Yaddessalage Bana of Rahala; is well known to Pina Vidane Duraya of Rahala and Mudiyanse Gan-arachchi of Aramawasama. The Police Magistrate of Kegalla has issued warrant No. 4,014 for his arrest.

SEYNA IDEROOS; charged with criminal breach of trust at Municipal market, Kandy, on October 17, 1905; is a Malayalam Moor; religion, Mohammedan; occupation, cooly; age, about 30 years; height, 5 ft. 5 in.; make thin; complexion, dark; nose, pointed; teeth, well set; eyes, black, small; hair, black, shaved; wears moustaches; birthplace, Malayalam; general residence, Kandy; haunts Colombo, Kandy, Gampola, Matale, and Badulla; wife and children are at Buwelikada, Kandy; brothers, Kananna Meera Saibo of Gas street, No. 5, Colombo, and Seyna Nagore Meera of Buwelikada, Kandy; cousins, Seyna Packeer and Seyna Pitche of Kandy; father-in-law, Uduwan Pulle of Katukela; is well known to P. C. No. 608 Kuda Banda and P. C. 709 Muse Lebbe of Kandy. The Police Magistrate of Kandy has issued warrant No. 30,780 for his arrest.

MAHA ACHCHARIGE BABA SINNO; charged with theft at Udumulla in Induruwa on November 13, 1905; is a Sinhalese of Navandanna caste; religion, Buddhist; occupation, goldsmith; age, about 19 years; height about 5 ft.; make, spare; complexion, dark brown; eyes, black, round; hair, black, tied in a knot; wears slight beard; has a cut mark in the palm of the left hand; birthplace and general residence, Udumulla; haunts Colombo, Negombo, and Katunayaka; is single; father, Maha-achcharige Tambihami; is well known to the Police Officer of Induruwa. The Police Magistrate of Balapitiya has issued warrant No. 28,124 for his arrest.

JOHN SINGHO; charged with voluntarily causing hurt with knife at Trincomalee street, Kandy, on December 14, 1905; is a Sinhalese of the Goigama caste; religion, Buddhist; age, about 45 years; height, 5 ft. 7 in.; make, well built; complexion, dark; teeth, well set; eyes, brown and oval; hair, cut short, black, and parted on a side; wears moustache, beard and shaved; has cut marks on one of the cheeks; hands are tattooed; birthplace and general residence, Kandy; haunts Yatiyatota, Avisawella, Kadugannawa, and Kandy; wife, Anno Perera, resides at Torrington road; brother, William Arachchi. Resthouse-keeper of Hanguranketa; is well known to policemen of Kandy. The Police Magistrate of Kandy has issued warrant No. 3,931 for his arrest.
