## DRAFT ORDINANCE.

#### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :---

#### An Ordinance to provide for the increase of the Export Duty on Tea.

HEREAS it is expedient to provide for an increase of the export duty levied on tea for the purpose of

increasing the consumption of Ceylon tea in foreign lands: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows: 1 This Ordinance shall come into operation at such time

1 This Ordinance shall come into operation at such time as the Governor shall, by Proclamation published in the Government Gazette, appoint.

2 From and after the time when this Ordinance shall come into operation there shall be raised, levied, and paid upon all tea of the produce of this island exported beyond seas a duty not exceeding thirty cents per one hundred pounds, the rate leviable to be determined by the Governor in Executive Council from time to time, upon consideration

of levy of export duty and rate of duty. of such recommendations as may be made by the joint committee appointed by the Planters' Association of Ceylon on the day of , and by the Chamber of Commerce on the day of , or the successors in office of such committee, to administer the funds raised under this Ordinance, and such duty shall be independent of, and in addition to, any duty which may be imposed under the provisions of "The Medical Wants Ordinance, 1880, Amendment Ordinance, 1882."

3 The duty under this Ordinance shall be levied at the Customs on the entry for exportation of tea, and shall be payable to, and shall be collected and received by, the
