PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS HIS EXCELLANCY THE RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR J. WEST RIDGEWAY, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Knight Commander of the Most Exalted Order of the Star of India, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof, has quitted this Colony on leave of absence: It is hereby proclaimed that by virtue of HIS MAJESTY'S Commission, bearing date the 6th day of July, 1901, EVERARD FERDINAND IM THURN, Esquire, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, has this day assumed the Administration of the Government of this Island, and has taken the Oaths accordingly; of which all persons concerned are required to take due notice.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Twenty-fifth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Two.
