WEERASINGHE WILLIAM SILVA; charged with voluntarily causing hurt with a knife at Pohaddramulla on November 29, 1901; is a Sinhalese of the Halagama caste; religion, Buddhist; occupation, cinnamon peeler; age, about 30 years; height, 5 ft. 6 in.; make, thin; complexion, black; nose, long; hair, black, long, and tied in a knot; wears moustaches and beard; birthplace, Pohaddramulla; general residence, Rayigama; haunts Rayigama, Pohaddramulla, Colombo; father, Weerasinghe Poloris; uncle, Thigo Arachchige Manuel Silva of Pohaddramulla; is well known to the Police Vidane of Pohaddramulla. The Police Magistrate of Panadure has issued warrant No. 11,584 for his arrest.

KAVIRATANA AUNERIS SILVA; charged with voluntarily causing hurt with a knife at Pohaddramulla on November 29, 1901; is a Sinhalese of the Halagama caste; religion, Buddhist; age, about 30 years; height, 5 ft. 6 in.; make, stout; complexion, brown; teeth, cut short; eyes, brown; hair, black, long, and tied in a knot; wears full beard and moustaches; birthplace, Pohaddramulla; general residence, Pohaddramulla; haunts Kalamulla, Negombo, Colombo, and Chilaw; father, Kaviratna Anoris Silva of Pohaddramulla; is well known to the Police Vidane of Pohaddramulla. The Police Magistrate of Panadure has issued warrant No. 11,584 for his arrest.

SUSAHAWAGE SADRIS FERNANDO; charged with voluntarily causing hurt at Katakalahawatta, Potupitiya, on February 11, 1902; is a Sinhalese of the Hinnawa caste; religion, Buddhist; occupation, carter; age, about 48 years; height, about 5 ft. 2 in.; make, stout; complexion, dark brown; nose, pointed; mouth, small; hair, black, long, and tied in a knot; wears moustaches, beard shaved; birthplace, Potupitiya; general residences, Potupitiya, Polgasowita; haunts Ratnapura and Colombo; relations, Susahawage Juwanis of Mahawaskaduwa, Jayatungehewage Johanna of Kudawaskaduwa; is well known to the Police Headmen of Potupitiya. The Police Magistrate of Panadure has issued warrant No. 12,091 for his arrest.

UDUWAKA ACHARIGE CORNELIS; charged with house-breaking and theft at Dangedara on March 13, 1902; is a Sinhalese of the Acharia caste; religion, Buddhist; age, about 60 years; height, about 5 ft.; make, stout; complexion, dark brown; nose, slightly prominent; has teeth in front only; eyes, round and reddish; hair, gray, and tied in a small knot; wears moustaches; beard shaved; has a cut mark on right thigh, another on right forearm, two healed boil marks near the wrists; birthplace, Madapathaladangedara in Galle District; general residence, Uggalkal-tota in up-country; haunts Sinharajadavia, Yatinuwara, Ratnapura, and Trincomalee; wife, D. F. Augohamy, is living at Kumbalwella; brothers, Uduwaka Acharige Samichechi Mudalali and Baron Singho, both of Madapatala, and Uduwaka Acharige Bastian of Kandy; is well known to Panadure Lokuruge Babaihamy of Dangedara, Miti Eliashamy, and Y. MARTIN AMARASINHE; charged with dishonestly misappropriating stamps belonging to Mr. A. F. Herat, Proctor, Kegalla, at Kegalla on April 23, 1902; is a Sinhalese of the Goigama caste; religion, Roman Catholic; occupation, petition-drawer; age, about 35 years; height, 5 ft. 5 in.; complexion, dark brown; has white marks on lips; teeth, irregular; eyes, hazel and oval; hair, black, and cropped short; wears moustaches; stoops slightly when walking; birthplace, Kegalla; general residence, Kegalla; haunts Kurunegala, Vevuda, and Urugoda; wife, Ana Victoria, and two children are living at Kegalla; brothers, Gabriel Sooraweera Notary and Publino of Kegalla; brothers-in-law, Herat Wijesinghe of Vevuda, Ruben of Kurunegala District, and William of Kurunegala District; is well known to all the Court and Police Officers of Kegalla.
