T is hereby notified that the Council of Legal Education has, by resolution duly passed at a meeting held on the 19th day of October, 1906, dispensed with the subjects prescribed in rule 8 of Schedule III. to "The Courts Ordinance, 1889," for the Preliminary Examination of Proctor candidates, and in rule 35 of the said Schedule for the Preliminary Examination of Advocate candidates, and substituted therefor the

Preliminary Examination for Proctors.

The Preliminary Examination for the admission of Proctors, from and after the 1st day of October, 1907, shall be :-

(1) The Matriculation Examination of the University of London; or

The Final Examination in Arts of any Indian University; or
