#### ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

#### ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS FOR MONTH OF DECEMBER, 1906.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: maha paddy plants are here and there already in ear.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: vegetables and fruit were scarce and dear. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not satisfactory during the month. In five korales out of the eight korales of Colombo District the crop for the month is reported at 4,155,200 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 6.50 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 65 a thousand.

Rainfall: there were a few showers of rain during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a fairly good maha crop may be expected if the paddy plants

are not damaged by the recent floods.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: with the exception of a few cases of fever, dysentery, and chickenpox in some parts of the district, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

#### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha cultivation is thriving fairly.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: vegetables, yams, and fruits scarce. Flowering of coconuts slow and uncertain; prospects of crop, poor; actual crop for the month, 2,437,890 nuts.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 50 to Rs. 7 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 45 to Rs. 90 per 1,000.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: fair.

Rinfall: total 3.45 in.; mean 11 in.

Health of people: good, except for a few cases of dysentery and chickenpox.

Health of cattle: good.

#### CENTRAL PROVINCE.

#### KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy: maha-the paddy is blossoming, except in Pata Dumbara and Pata Hewaheta, in which divisions it is being transplanted; yala—nil.

Dry grain: maha—hill paddy in Udunuwara, Tumpane, Harispattu, Pata Dumbara, and Uda

Dumbara is blossoming, and in Pata Hewaheta kurakkan chenas are being weeded; yala—nil.

Rainfall: sufficient.

Prospect of coconut crop: flowering of coconut is good in Udunuwara, Tumpane, and Udapalata; in Harispattu and Pata Dumbara blossom is poor. Produce for the month of December, 1906: in Udunuwara 607,200 nuts, Tumpane 23,700 nuts, Harispattu 10,999 nuts; in other divisions actual crop is not ascertainable.

Health of people: good.

Health of cattle: good, except twenty cases of hoof-and-mouth disease in Pata Hewsheta. Prices: paddy, Rs. 2.50 per bushel; kurakkan, Rs. 2 per bushel; rice, Rs. 5 per busel; coconuts, Rs. 6 per 100.

#### NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy: Kotmale—paddy plants blossoming: Uda Hewaheta and Walapane—operations for the maha cultivation commenced.

Dry grain: Walapane and Uda Hewaheta -- kurakkan and Indian corn plants looking healthy.

Rainfall: there was sufficient rain during the month.

Health of population: on the whole satisfactory.

Health of cattle: good.

Coconuts: In Uda Hewaheta the prospects, judging from the flowers, are good; in the other two divisions the plantations are so small that the produce is not worth taking into account.

#### MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall registered at Matale: 1.62 in.

Paddy: maha fields are now in plant and promising; ploughing is yet going on in some parts.

Dry grain: maha chenas are now in plant.

Coconut: (a) promising; (b) yielded good crops. Price of coconuts is very high. Actual crop cannot be given; will try to include approximately in future.

Tanks in Matale North are full.

Health of people: good. Health of cattle : good.

Prices: high.

#### NORTHERN PROVINCE.

#### JAFFNA DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 5.71 in.

Weather: wind from the north-west, north-east, south-west, and south-east.

Paddy cultivation: the paddy plants are in ear.

Dry grain cultivation: varaku and karuttasamy in ear; payaru and ulunthu are in plant.

Tobacco cultivation: nil.

Other products: coconuts, average yield, as usual; palmirahs, nil. Heath of people: not good; fever and measles prevail in some places.

Health of cattle: satisfactory.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Re. 1 87 per bushel; rice, Rs. 5 25 per bushel; payaru, Rs. 3 76 per bushel.

#### MANNAR DISTRICT.

Weather: rainfall, 4.07 in.; wind, variable.

Agriculture: paddy—sowing for the "kalapokam" is over; the plants are in various stages of growth, but they are affected by a disease called "sental" (red stem); tobacco—the gardens are being planted, the process having been considerably delayed by the heavy rain. Dry grains are being harvested. Coconuts are beginning to flower after the rain; the crop for the month was poor.

Health of people: unsatisfactory. The heavy rains have been followed by a serious outbreak of fever.

Health of cattle: good.

Prices of grain: rice, Rs. 5 25 per bushel; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 6 per 100.

#### MULLAITTIVU DISTRICT.

Weather: there was constant rain throughout the month, and the north-east wind blew strong. Dew

fell at night whenever it was clear and the wind dropped.

State of crops: (1) the paddy crop in manavari lands and tank beds is doing well, and is in blossom and ear; there is promise of an excellent harvest; paddy on lands under tanks is in blade. (2) Kurakkan in chenas is also doing well; it is mostly in ear. (3) Coconuts are flowering well, and the prospects are good; the crop for the month is 41,450 nuts.

Health of people: poor; fever and dysentery prevailed to an unusual extent, probably owing to the abnormal rainfall after a long drought and to the scarcity of good food.

Health of cattle: good.

Prices of staple articles of food: paddy, Rs. 2.75 per bushel; rice, Rs. 6 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel; kurak-kan, Rs. 2.50 per bushel; varaku, Re. 1.75 per bushel; ellu, Rs. 4.50 per bushel; kollu, Rs. 3 per bushel; ulunthu, Rs. 4.50 per bushel; payaru, Rs. 4.50 per bushel.

#### SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

#### GALLE DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha crops are now full grown, and a fair harvest may be expected.

Miscellaneous: the food supply of the people has continued to be satisfactory. Imported articles of food were available at moderate prices; coconuts were scarce and dear.

Prices of staple food: rice, Rs. 10:50 to Rs. 11 per bag; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; fine grain, Rs. 2 per bushel.

Health: the health of the people in the district has on the whole satisfactory, except for a few cases of dysentery.

Cultivation, paddy: maha cultivation is in progress. In some villages the fields are being sown and in some they are being ploughed, whilst the fields in the rest have young plants.

Kurakkau: chenas have young crops; in a few villages the crops are reaching maturity.

Tavalu: (tank-bed) chenas have young crops.

Other products: coconuts flowering well in Tamankaduwa; in Nuwarakalawiya they are not flowering now. Estimated coconut crops gathered during the month is 4,346 nuts.

Health of people: fair; fever prevails to some extent in some villages.

Health of cattle: satisfactory. Village tanks: many tanks are full.

#### PROVINCE OF UVA

#### BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather: generally wet.

Paddy: fields are being ploughed for the maha harvest.

Chenas: chena crops throughout the Province are almost ripe.

Fruits and vegetables: fruits are searce and dear; vegetables are plentiful and cheap.

Health of people: fair; an epidemic of cholers which prevaled in almost all the divisions has subsided. Fever accompanied by cough is prevailing throughout the Province.

Health of cattle: satisfactory.

Other products: (a) the flowering and prospects of coconuts are fair; (b) the crop for the month is about 145,750.

#### PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

#### RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy: in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, Atakalan, and Kukul korales maha crops are blossoming; prospects are fairly satisfactory. In Nawadun korale second maha crops are prepared for sowing; prospects are not satisfactory. In Kadawata and Meda korales preparations are being made for the yala cultivation, and the pera-maha crops are about a month old.

Fine grain: in Kuruwiti korale el-wi chenas are harvested, in Atakalan korale they are ripening, and in Kukul korale about three months old; in Kuruwiti korale chenas for pera-yala cultivation are being cleared. Weather is favourable. In Nawadun, Kolonna, Kadawata, and Meda korales maha chenas are blossoming. In Kuruwiti korale owiti crops are ripe and kurakkan sown. In Tambagam and Kandawel pattu of Atakalan korale kurakkan crops are ripening.

Other products: coconuts in Kuruwiti korale: estimated crop 20,000; prospects not good. In Nawadun and Atakalan korales there is no particular season for flowering. October and November flowers give a good crop; actual monthly crop is unascertainable. In Kolonna korale very few coconut trees: estimated crop, 400; prospects favourable. In Kadawata and Meda korales prospects good: estimated crop, 4,700. In Kukul korale flowering not commenced; prospects not ascertainable; monthly crop estimated at 400 nuts.

The health of the people is satisfactory, except in Kadawata and Meda korales, where fever is still

prevalent.

Cattle enjoy immunity from murrain.

The prices of food products are: rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 50 per bushel; paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2 75 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 25 to Rs. 2 50 per bushel; amu, 50 cents to Re. 1 per bushel; muneta, Rs. 4 to Rs. 4 50 per bushel; meneri. Re. 1 to Re. 1 50 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 8 to Rs. 18 per 100; salt, 10 cents to 25 cents per measure.

#### KEGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy: maha prospects are good.

Dry grain: hill paddy, iringu, and amu prospects are good; kurakkan chenas are being sown.

Prices: paddy. Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2 per bushel; el-wi, Re. 1.50 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 per bushel; anu. 75 cents.

Rainfall: Kegalla, 8.93 in.; Ruwanwella, 7.40 in.

Cattle disease: there were a few cases of anthrax at Medagoda in Three Korales.

Health of people: normal.

Other products: (a) the flowering prospects of coconuts, good; (b) the actual crop for the month, 1.538,375 nuts.
