## ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

### ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY, 1907.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : the maha harvest is being reaped and threshed. Preparations for the yala are in progress.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : the supply of vegetables was good and prices were moderate, but fruit was scarce and dear. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not satisfactory during the month. Owing to the drought and intervening rain a large number of tender nuts dropped off the trees. The crop for the month is reported at 7,368,208 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 70 a thousand.

Rainfall : there were a few showers of rain.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : the maha crop gathered is considered to be fairly good.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants : with the exception of a few cases of fever, dysentery, and chickenpox in some parts of the district, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

##### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the maha cultivation is being reaped ; a fair crop is expected. Preparations are being made for the yala cultivation.

Dry grain : nothing worth reporting.

Other products : (a) there has been a fair supply of vegetables ; (b) fruits, scarce ; (c) crop of coconuts for the month, 123,724 ; (d) flowering unsatisfactory, and prospects of coming crops poor.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 90 per 1,000.

Remarks on harvest prospects : fair.

## PUTTALAM DISTRICT.

Paddy : in some parts the crops have been reaped, and in some others the crop is maturing.

Fine grain crops have been gathered.

Prices of staple products : rice, varies from Rs. 5·25 to Rs. 6 a bushel ; paddy, varies from Re. 1 to Re. 1·50 a bushel ; kurakkan, varies from Re. 1·12 to Re. 1·37 a bushel ; coconut, varies from Rs. 5 to Rs. 6 per 100.

Health : satisfactory ; fever, pneumonia, and dysentery prevailed to some extent during the month.

Cattle : free from disease.

Flowering and prospects of coconuts : (a) coconut trees look very healthy, and are blossoming ; (b) prospects good.

Rainfall : 1·94 in.

## CHILAW DISTRICT.

*Pitigal Korale North.*

Paddy : ma-wi and elankali sown for maha harvest being reaped ; bala-wi cultivation attained maturity.

Tobacco : maha cultivation is in good condition.

Coconuts : about 500 trees blossomed, and about 2,597,100 nuts gathered.

Fish : catch worth about Rs. 5,000.

Health of people : fever is prevailing in some villages.

Health of cattle : fairly good.

*Pitigal Korale Central.*

Paddy : maha crop is being reaped.

Fine grain : about 50 bushels sown, the crop is good, and has been harvested.

Coconuts : about 7,107,450 nuts gathered.

Fish : catch worth about Rs. 1,445.

Health of people : fever, chickenpox, and dysentery prevailed to some extent, but the latter has been stamped out.

Health of cattle : good.

Paddy : maha crop is being reaped in some villages, and in some villages it is being threshed.

Tobacco : there has been no tobacco cultivation.

Fruits : scarce.

Fish : scarce.

Coconuts : about 5,850,000 nuts gathered.

Health of people : good ; weather is dry and hot.

Health of cattle : good.

## NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

## ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather : dry.

Rainfall : 1·56 in. registered at Anuradhapura during the month. There was no rain in Tamankaduwa district, but there were a few showers throughout the rest of the Province.

Paddy : the fields cultivated for the maha harvest are reaching maturity ; prospects favourable ; the yala fields are being ploughed.

Kurakkan chenas are being reaped in Nuwarakalawiya, and in Tamankaduwa they are reaching maturity. Tavalu (tank bed) chenas are being reaped.

Other products : coconut trees flowering well ; estimated crop gathered during the month is 3,000 nuts

Health of people : fair. Fever prevails to some extent in some villages.

Health of cattle : fair. There were a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease among cattle during the month in Eppawala korale.

Village tanks : most of the tanks are full ; a few are three-quarters or half full.

## PROVINCE OF UVA.

## BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather : hot and dry.

Paddy : sowing of fields for the maha harvest is nearly over.

Chenas : crops are still being gathered. The yield is said to be exceptionally good.

Fruits and vegetables : fruits are scarce and dear. Chena vegetables are abundant and cheap, but garden vegetables are scarce.

Other products : (a) the flowering of coconut trees is fair, and there are prospects of a good crop ; (b) the crop for the month is about 563,067 nuts.

Health of people : satisfactory. Some cases of fever, sore-eyes, and dysentery have been reported from some divisions.

Health of cattle : satisfactory in general, except in Wellassa division, where foot-and-mouth disease prevailed.

## PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

## RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy : in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, and Atakalan korales the maha crop has been gathered. In Nawadun korale the second maha paddy plants are one month old. In Atakalan and Kolonna korales fields for the yala harvest are being prepared for sowing. In Nawadun korale the weather is favourable for the second maha cultivation. In Kolonna korale there is sufficient rain.

Fine grain : in Nawadun, Kukul, Kolonna, Meda, and Kadawat korales, and in Kandawel pattu and Tambagam pattu of Atakalan korale the maha crop has been gathered, and the weather is favourable. In Kuruwiti korale the perayala chenas are being prepared for sowing, and the weather is favourable.

Other products : coconuts—in Kuruwiti korale the crop gathered is satisfactory, and is estimated at 12,850 nuts. In Nawadun korale there is no particular season for flowering. In Kukul korale the flowering is unsatisfactory, and the crop gathered is about 500 nuts. In Meda and Kadawat korales the flowering and the crops are favourable ; the crop gathered is estimated at 18,000 nuts. In Kolonna korale there are only a very few plantations. The flowering is good, and the crop gathered is about 300 nuts.

Health of the people : the health of the people throughout the district is satisfactory, except in Meda and Kadawat korales, where there were a few cases of dysentery. The cattle are free from murrain and other diseases.

The prices of articles of food are : rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 6.75 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2.75 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Rs. 2.25 per bushel ; amu, 50 cents to Re. 1 per bushel ; salt, 10 cents to 25 cents per measure ; coconuts, Rs. 10 to Rs. 18 per 100 nuts.

## KEGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy : maha fields have been harvested ; the yield is good.

Dry grain : hill paddy, iringu, and amu have been harvested ; the yield is good.

Prices : paddy, Re. 1.50 per bushel ; el-wi, Re. 1.50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 per bushel ; amu, 75 cents per bushel.

Rainfall : Kegalla, 1.06 in. ; Ruanwella, 3.43 in.
