ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY, 1907.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha harvest is being reaped and threshed. Preparations for the yala are in progress.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables was good and prices were moderate, but fruit was scarce and dear. The flowering and prospects of ecconuts were not satisfactory during the month. Owing to the drought and intervening rain a large number of tender nuts dropped off the trees. The crop for the month is reported at 7,368,208 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 70 a thousand.

Rainfall: there were a few showers of rain.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: the maha crop gathered is considered to be fairly good.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: with the exception of a few cases of fever, dysentery, and chickenpox in some parts of the district, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha cultivation is being reaped; a fair crop is expected. Preparations are being made for the yala cultivation.

Dry grain: nothing worth reporting.

Other products: (a) there has been a fair supply of vegetables; (b) fruits, scarce; (c) crop of coconuts for the month, 123,724; (d) flowering unsatisfactory, and prospects of coming crops poor.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 per bashel; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 90 per 1,000.

Remarks on harvest prospects: fair.
Rainfall: total, 1.95 in.; mean, '07 in.
Health of people: good. There were only a few cases of dysentery and chickenpox.

Health of cattle: good.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha: the paddy in all the divisions is being harvested, except in Tumpane, in which division paddy plants are blossoming. Crop or prospect of crop: good. Yala: nil.

Dry grain: hill paddy in Udunuwara, Tumpane, and Pata Dumbara is being harvested, and in other divisions chenas are being cleared for cultivation.

Yala : nil.

Rainfall: insufficient.

Prospect of coconut crop: flowering of coconut is good in Udunuwara, Yatinuwara, and Tumpane, and in other divisions not satisfactory. Produce for the month of February: Udunuwara, nil; Yatinuwara, 4.000; Tumpare, 15,150; Haris pattu, 11,256; Uda Bulatgama, 1,044. In other divisions actual crop is not ascertainable.

Health of people: good. Health of cattle: good.

Prices: paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 50 per bushel; rice, Rs. 6 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 10 per 100.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy: Kotmale-reaping continued; Walapane and Uda Hewaheta-paddy plants looking healthy. Dry grain: Kotmale-no work on chenas. Walapane and Uda Hewaheta-being reaped; prospects good.

Rainfall: insufficient.

Health of population: there were few cases of chickenpox in Kotmale and fever in Walapane.

Health of cattle: there were a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease in some villages of Uda Hewaheta. Coconuts: flowering bad owing to dry weather; crop during the month, about 6,000.
