FINAL ORDERS.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Grown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Alutgelandehena, Elhendeniyehena, Ittagodahena, &c., situate in the village of Ketiyape in the Kandaboda pattu of the Matara District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
