Other products : the supply of vegetables and fruit was good, and prices were moderate. The flowering and prospects of coconuts appear to be slightly better than during the past two or three months. The crop for the month is reported at 9,911,823 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 3. 75 to Rs. 6 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 60 a thousand.

Rainfall : the rainfall was below the average.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a good yala harvest may be generally expected, provided fair and seasonable weather happens to prevail. Observations on the health of the inhabitants : with the exception of a few cases of fever, dysentery, and

chickenpox in some parts of the district, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.
