FINAL ORDER.

Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Kiringalamukalana, situate in the village of Tellaka, in the Tumpalata pattu of the Paranakuru korale in the Kegalla District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

THE notice required by section 1 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," having been duly published in manner prescribed by that section in respect of the above-named land (*vide* Notice No. 982), and no claim having been made to the said land or to any interest therein within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, the Assistant Government Agent for the Kegalla District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 2 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on this Twenty-eighth day of February, 1907, order and declare that the said land, as more fully described herein below, situate in the village of Tellaka, in the Tumpalata pattu of the Paranakuru korale in the Kegalla District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and shown as lots 1443, 1444a, in preliminary plan No. 550 and in the annexed certified tracing therefrom, and containing in extent 16 acres 2 roods and 39 perches, is the property of the Crown.

The original lot 1444 appearing in the notice has been subdivided into lots 1444 and 1444a, containing in extent 4 acres 3 roods and 9 perches and 16 acres and 30 perches, respectively. The former, namely, lot 1444, which has been marked off to the north of lot 1444a on the said preliminary plan 550, is hereby withdrawn from the notice.

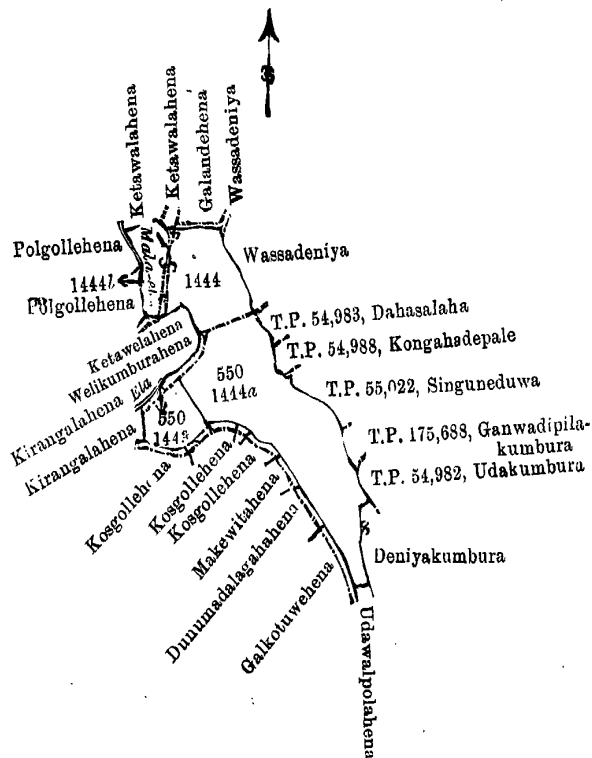
