Target Practice.

THE Classification in General Circular No. 213 of September 12, 1902, is hereby cancelled, and the following order substituted: order substituted :-

Any man scoring 95 points and over will be styled a Marksman, and will be entitled to wear a gold badge for one year and be awarded a money prize of Rs. 2.50. A Marksman for three consecutive years will be entitled to wear the badge permanently.

Those scoring 85 points and under 95 will be styled first class shots, and will be entitled to wear a silver

badge for one year and be awarded a money prize of Re. 1.

Those scoring 70 points and under 85 be styled second class shots, and will be entitled to wear red cloth badge for one year.
