Rainfall: there was very little rain during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a fairly good maha crop may be generally expected. Observations on the health of the inhabitants: with the exception of a few cases of fever, chickenpox, and dysentery in some parts of the district, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

#### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: maha cultivation is in order.
