 Tanks : about half of the tanks have filled fairly.

## PROVINCE OF UVA.

## BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather : wet in Wellassa and normal in other divisions.  
 Paddy : fields are being cultivated for the maha ; the yala crop is being harvested.  
 Chenas : under crop.  
 Fruits and vegetables : sufficient, except in Wellassa and Yatikinda divisions.  
 Health of people : fairly good. There were some cases of vomiting and purging in Wegampattu Korale of Wellassa division, and in Maspanna Wasama of Udukinda division.  
 Health of cattle : fair. Foot- and-mouth disease appeared among the black cattle in Kalupana Wasama of the Wellawaya division, but is fast dying out.

## PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

## RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy : in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, Atakalan, and Kukul korales maha crops are blossoming. Prospects are favourable. In Kadawata and Meda korales peramaha fields have been sown. Weather favourable.  
 Dry grain : in Kuruwiti korale perayala chenas are ripening and yala chenas are blossoming. In Nawadun korale maha chenas are blossoming. In Atakalan korale el-wi chenas are blossoming and kurakkan chenas are ripening. In Kadawata and Meda korales Indian corn and muneta are flowering and kurakkan in the Bintenna is two months old. In Kukul korale amu chenas are blossoming.  
 The health of the people is not very satisfactory. Dysentery, fever, measles, &c., prevail in most places. In some parts hoof-and-mouth disease prevails among cattle.

The prices of food products are : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per bushel ; paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Re. 1.50 per bushel ; amu, 50 cents to Re. 1 per bushel ; meneri, 75 cents to Re. 1 per bushel ; muneta, Rs. 4 to Rs. 4.50 per bushel ; tana, 75 cents to Re. 1 per bushel ; cocoanuts, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per 100 nuts ; salt, 10 cents to 16 cents per measure.

## KEGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy : maha prospects are good.  
 Dry grain : hill paddy, iringu, and amu prospects are good. Hill paddy sown in Three Korales and Lower Bulatgama and iringu sown in Beligal korale are being reaped. Iringu sown with hill paddy and kurakkan chenas in Three Korales have been reaped.

Prices : paddy, Re. 1.25 to Re. 1.50 per bushel ; hill paddy, Re. 1.25 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 per bushel ; amu, 75 cents per bushel.

Rainfall : Kegalla, 1.83 in. ; Ruanwella, 1.13 in.

Cattle disease : health of cattle is good, except a few cases of foot-and-mouth disease (kuraleda) reported from Three Korales.

Health of people : fair ; cases of fever, diarrhoea, and measles have been reported in various divisions.
