SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF JULY, 1907.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : yala plants are generally thriving, and are here and there already in ear. Sowing for maha has commenced in some villages.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : the supply of vegetables and fruit was good, and prices were fair. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not so good as last month. The crop for the month is reported at 11,032,821 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 5 75 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 53 a thousand. Rainfall : the rainfall was sufficient for the purposes of cultivation.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a good yala harvest may be generally expected. Observations on the health of the inhabitants : with the exception of a few cases of typhoid fever. malarial fever, chickenpox, dysentery, and of four cases of smallpox in some villages, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.
