PROCLAMATIONS BY THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR.

IN the Name of His Majesty EDWARD THE SEVENTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency EVERARD FERDINAND IM THURN, Esquire, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

EVERARD IM THURN.

WHEREAS by section 3 of the Ordinance No. 19 of 1896, intituled "An Ordinance to declare certain by-laws to be in force within the Municipality of Kandy," it is enacted that the by-laws set forth in the schedule thereto shall be in force within the Municipality of Kandy, provided, however, that nothing contained in the said Ordinance shall be held or construed to prevent the making, approval, and publication in respect of the Municipality of Kandy of further by-laws or by-laws in amendment, repeal of, or in addition to, such by-laws in the same and the like manner as is empowered to be done by the provisions of "The Municipal Councils' Ordinances, 1887, 1890, and 1896," or any other Ordinance:

And whereas by section 6 of the Ordinance No. 8 of 1901, it is enacted (1) that no by-law or revocation, amendment, alteration, or variation of any by-law shall have effect until the same is confirmed by the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, and (2) that all by-law when so confirmed shall be published in two successive issues of the *Government Gazette* in the English, Sinhalese, and Tamil languages, and shall be laid before the Legislative Council if then in Session, and if not then in Session then so soon as possible after the commencement of the next ensuing Session,

and if within forty days after their being so laid before the Legislative Council any of such by-laws be objected to by the Legislative Council, the said Council may by resolution amend or annul any such by-laws, and (3) that all such by-laws so amended and such by-laws as shall not be amended or annulled by the said Council shall be proclaimed in two successive issues of the *Government Gazette* in the English, Sinhalese, and Tamil languages, and shall come into force upon such Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, and shall thereupon be as legal, valid, effectual, and binding as if the same had been enacted in the said Ordinance :

And whereas the by-laws set forth in the schedule hereto has been made in respect of the Municipality of Kandy, under the provisions of section 122 of the said "Municipal Councils' Ordinance, 1887," as amended by section 4 of the said Ordinance No. 8 of 1901, and the same has, under section 124 of the said Municipal Councils' Ordinance, 1887, as amended by section 6 of the Ordinance No. 8 of 1901, been confirmed by the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council :

And whereas the said by-laws having been so confirmed was in manner aforesaid published in the *Government Gazette* and laid before the Legislative Council ; and whereas the period of forty days after its being so laid before the Legislative Council has expired, and the said by-law not having been objected to by the said Council, it is hereby proclaimed that the said by-laws set forth in the schedule hereto shall be substituted for by-laws 15 and 18 of chapter XV., in the schedule to Ordinance No. 19 of 1896 aforesaid, and the same shall take effect as from and after the First day of September, 1902.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Nineteenth day of August, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Two.

15. The driver of every licensed carriage and the cooly of every licensed jinricksha shall be cleanly dressed, and shall wear a coat and badge, which shall be provided by the Council (at the cost of the owners of such carriages), and such badge shall bear a number corresponding with the number of the license granted in respect of such carriage.

By-laws on Dogs.

1. *Registration of Dogs.*—All dogs kept within the limits of the Municipality shall be registered in the office of the Municipal Council and shall be produced to the Chairman before registration.
2. *Registration Fee.*—An annual registration fee of Re. 1 shall be payable for each dog kept within the said limits.
3. *Certificate of Registration.*—The certificate of registration referred to in section 5 of Ordinance No. 25 of 1901, shall be in the form given in the annexed schedule marked A.
4. *Owner of Dogs to give notice to Council.*—Every person who shall acquire, keep, or become possessed of a dog shall give notice thereof to the Council on or before the 31st March of each year, or within 21 days of his acquiring or becoming possessed of such dog, and shall give full description of the animal.
5. *Occupier to fill up Schedule.*—It shall be lawful to the Chairman of the Municipal Council before the 31st March in each year to require every occupier of a house to fill up a schedule in the Form B showing the number and description of the dogs kept in such house or in any premises attached thereto, and to whom they respectively belong, and every such occupier shall be bound to accept, duly fill in with correct information, and return such schedule within one week from receipt thereof.
6. *Refusal of Certificate.*—The Chairman may refuse to issue a certificate of registration to the owner of a dog if in the opinion of the Sanitary Officer such dog is by reason of its suffering from some infectious or contagious disease a source of danger to the public.
7. *Municipal Council may order Dogs to be Destroyed when Certificates has been Refused.*—The owner of every dog in respect of which a certificate has been refused or in respect of which the conditions attached to the certificate have not been complied with, shall on being noticed to do so, produce the dog before the Municipal Council, and the Municipal Council may, if it deem necessary, order the destruction of the dog.
8. *Collars for Dogs.*—Every dog kept within the limits of the Municipality shall wear a collar with the Municipal stamp, the registered number and year of registration stamped in it. A register of the stamping of collars shall be kept in the Municipal Office.
9. *Collars to be paid for if supplied by Council.*—The Chairman is hereby authorized to issue collars to every person applying for the same on a payment of Re. 1 per collar. The collar to be stamped without further charge.
10. *Stamping of Collars to be free.*—Every person desirous of providing a collar for his dog shall be allowed to obtain the Municipal stamp and number on it without any charge.
11. *Dogs seized to be Detained.*—All dogs seized under section 10 of Ordinance No. 25 of 1901, shall be delivered to the Police to be detained at the Pettah Police Station, or to such other person as the Chairman may on that behalf authorize.

12. *Payment to be made for Restoration of a Dog.*—No stray dog seized under the authority of the Chairman shall be restored to its owner without a payment of 50 cents for the first day and 25 cents a day for every subsequent day or part of a day in which the dog is detained, in addition to the registration fee if the dog has not been already registered.
