Paddy: the maha harvest is being reaped and threshed. Preparations for the yala are in progress.

 Other products: the supply of vegetables was good and prices were moderate, but fruit was rather scarce and dear.

 Rainfall: there was very little rain during the month.
 Remarks on harvest prospects generally: the maha crop gathered is considered to be generally good.
 Observations on the health of the inhabitants: with the exception of a few cases of fever, measles, chickenpox, typhoid fever, and dysentery in some parts of the district, and of a solitary case of smallpox in the village Kanatta, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.
