## DRAFT ORDINANCE.

## MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:-

> An Ordinance for the better Regulation of Printing Presses and of Bocks and Papers printed in Ceylon.

Preamble.

HEREAS it is expedient to provide for the regulation of printing presses and of books and papers printed in Ceylon: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Printing Presses Regulation Ordinance, 1902," and shall come into operation on a day to be notified by the Governor by Proclamation in the Government Gazette.

Keeper of printing press to make declaration.

- 2 (1) From and after the coming into operation of this Ordinance no person shall, within this colony, keep in his possession any press for the printing of books or papers, who shall not have made and subscribed the following declaration before a police magistrate:
- I, A. B., declare that I have a press for printing at and this last blank shall be filled up with a true and precise description of the place where such press is situate.
- (2) It shall be the duty of the police magistrate upon receiving any declaration made as aforesaid to forward the same to the government agent of the province, who shall file the same and register the particulars thereof in such form and manner as the Governor in Executive Council shall from time to time prescribe.
- (3) As often as the place where any printing press is kept is changed a new declaration shall be necessary.

Penalty for keeping press without making required declaration.

- 3 (1) Whoever shall keep in his possession any such press as aforesaid, without making such a declaration as is required by the last preceding section, shall on conviction be punished by fine not exceeding one hundred rupees, or by imprisonment of either description for a term not exceeding six months, or by both such punishments. For the purposes of this section the occupier of any premises in which any printing press is found shall be deemed to have kept the same in his possession, unless he proves the contrary.
- (2) Whoever in making any such declaration as aforesaid makes a statement which is false, and which he either knows or believes to be false, or does not believe to be true, shall on conviction be liable to the punishment prescribed by the last foregoing sub-section.

Printed book or paper to bear name of printer and publisher.

- 4 (1) Every book or paper printed within this colony shall have printed legibly on it the name in full of the printer and (if the book or paper be published) of the publisher and the place of publication. Provided that nothing in this section contained shall be taken to repeal, alter, or in any way affect the provisions of section 5 of Ordinance No. 5 of 1839, as regards the particulars required by the said section to be printed on newspapers.
- (2) Whoever shall print or publish any book or paper otherwise than in conformity with this section, or shall disperse or assist in dispersing any book or paper whereon the particulars required by this section have not been duly printed, shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable, on conviction thereof, to the punishment prescribed by the last preceding section.

Power to exclude books, &c., from operation of Ordinance.

5 The Governor in Executive Council may by notification in the Government Gazette exclude any class of books or papers, or any printing presses from the operation of the whole or any part or parts of this Ordinance.

6 No criminal prosecution of any person on account of any act alleged to be an offence under this Ordinance shall be commenced except with the permission first obtained of the Attorney-General.
