Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," admitting Lands to be Private Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Peelledowehena and Peelledowewatta, situate in the village of Hingurugamuwa in the Dambawinipalata korale of the Udukinda division, in the Province of Uva, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

HEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 12th day of June. One thousand Nine hundred and Three, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Peelledoweh ena and Peelledowewatta, situate in the village of Hingurugamuwa in the Dambawinipalata korale of the Udukinda division, in the Province of Uva, containing in extent I acre 2 roods and 15 perches, and shown as lots 11a and 11b in preliminary plan No. 74 and in the annexed certified tracings therefrom, was made to the Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such lands would be deemed the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 1.547):




