WHEREAS HIS EXCELLENCY SIR HENRY ARTHUR BLAKE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof, has quitted this Colony: It is hereby proclaimed that, by virtue of His Majesty's Commission, bearing date the Twenty-first day of January, 1907, HUGH CLIFFORD, Esquire, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, has this day assumed the Administration of the Government of this Island, of which all persons concerned are required to take due notice.
