ACCUSED PERSONS WANTED.

WELEGEDARA BANDIYA ; charged with cattle stealing on December 19, 1906, at Omaragalla ; is a Sinhalese of the Wahumpura caste ; religion, Buddhist ; occupation, cultivator ; age, 26 years ; height, about 5 ft. 6 in. ; make, thin ; complexion, fair ; nose, pointed ; mouth, small ; teeth, regular ; eyes, black and oval ; hair, black and tied in a knot ; has full beard ; has eruptions all over the body ; birthplace, Madampolakanda in Kurunegala District ; general residences, Madampolakanda and Ragedara ; haunts Rangammanawatta in Matala District and Ragedara in Hiriyala hatpattu ; is married ; has five persons in the family at Paragaha-ela in Hiriyala hatpattu ; is related to Welegedara Ma'liya, Kattaniyalededara Gam Komadu and Pina ; is well known to Anthony Pule of Ragedara. The Police Magistrate of Kurunegala has issued warrant No. 10,595 for his arrest.

KIRI BANDA ; charged with theft on February 29, 1907, at Rambodagalla ; is a Sinhalese cooly ; religion, Buddhist ; age, 30 years ; height, 5 ft 6 in. ; complexion, brown ; teeth, regular ; eyes, black and oval ; hair, black and tied in a knot ; has moustaches ; beard, sh. ved ; has vaccine marks on right arm ; birthplace and general residence, Horamune in Kurunegala District ; haunts Kegalla ; wife, Punchi Menika ; has four children ; is related to Gonigoda Muhiwattegedara Appuhamy ; is well known to Horamune Mudalihamy. JOKINO ; charged with voluntarily causing hurt by means of an instrument on March 28, 1907, at Walahapitiya ; is a Sinhalese of the Wahumpura caste ; religion, Buddhist ; occupation, carter ; age, 30 years ; height, 5 ft. 8 in. ; make, well made ; complexion, dark brown ; teeth, well set ; eyes, black ; hair, long and tied in a knot ; hair on face, scanty and shaved ; birthplace, Wanawahala in Alutkuru Korale South ; haunts Negombo ; is single ; is well known to Police Headman of Walahapitiya. The Police Magistrate of Chilaw has issued warrant No. 26,673 for his arrest.

MALEWA TANTIRIGE JUWANIS ; charged with theft of a bull and a hackery on June 1, 1907, at Welipta in Gangaboda pattu ; is a Sinhalese of the Goigama caste ; religion, Buddhist ; occupation, cooly ; age, 22 years ; height, 5 ft. ; make, thin ; mouth, broad ; eyes, small ; hair, black and tied in a knot ; teeth, well set ; wears slight moustaches ; birthplace and general residence, Kimbiya in Talpe pattu ; haunts Dodanduwa and Galle ; is single ; mother, Babahamy of Udugama ; is well known to ex-Constable Arachchi of Aknimana and Police Officer of Katukoliya. Perera, and Manis Perera, all of Mahawadduwa East; is well known to Police Vidane No. 698 D. P. Gunatillake of Mahawadduwa East. The Police Magistrate of Panadure has issued warrant No. 25,683 for his arrest.

COORAY; charged with theft of coconuts on June, 1907, at Getambe; is a Sinhalese of the Goigama caste; religion, Buddhist; occupation, cooly; age, about 30 years; height, 5 ft. 3 in.; make, thin; complexion, brown; teeth, regular; eyes, black; hair, cropped; wears moustaches; no beard; birthplace, Mahara; general residence, Getambe; haunts Peradeniya, Kandy, and Deltota; wife, Mango Nona of Getambe; friend, Marshall of Tunukumbura; is well known to Police Sergeant Gunawardena and Police Constable No. 72 Siyathu of Peradeniya. The Police Magistrate of Kandy has issued warrant No. 10,206 for his arrest.

JALIS alias PELIS; charged with theft of coconuts on June 17, 1907, at Patiniwatta; is a Sinhalese of the Goigama caste; religion, Buddhist; occupation, cooly; age, 30 years; height, about 5 ft.; make, fat; complexion, fair; teeth, regular; eyes, blue and round; hair, black, short, and tied in a knot; wears moustaches; beard, shaved; general residences, Patiniwatta, Minhettiya, and Wiharama; wife at Minhettiya; friends, Pitawala Appu and Homatagama Punchirala; is well known to Patiniwatta Appuhami, Gan-arachchi, Appuhami, Korala Arachchi of Patiniwatta, and J. W. Rovel of Gondamana estate. The Police Magistrate of Kurunegala has issued warrant No. 12,007 for his arrest.

RAJAPAKSEWELHENG DON BEMPY APPU; charged with voluntarily causing hurt with a knife on June 25, 1907, at Welhena; is a Sinhalese of the Goigama caste; religion, Buddhist; occupation, cultivator; age, 25 years; height, 5 ft 1 in.; make, medium; complexion, fair; hair, black and tied in a knot; has slight moustaches; birthplace and general residence, Welhena in Alutkuru korale; present residence, Chilaw; haunts Kurunegala and Henaragoda; uncle, Peeris Sinno of Welhena; sister, Alisahamy of Yathena; friend, Sadiris of Puthaduwawa; is well known to Police Vidanes of Welhena and Nadagomuwa. The Police Magistrate of Negombo has issued warrant No. 6,985 for his arrest.

TIKKOLAGE MUDALIHAMY; charged with voluntarily causing hurt with a knife on June 28, 1907, at Madaluwa; is a Sinhalese of the Goigama caste; religion, Buddhist; occupation, cooly; age, 16 years; height, 4 ft. 6 in.; make, well built; complexion, dark brown; eyes, black and oval; hair, black, long, and tied in a knot; teeth, well set; expression of countenance, morose; a scar on left ankle; birthplace, general residence, and present residence, Dampe in Colombo District; occasional residence, Handapangoda; haunts Colombo; single; uncles, Takkalage Mangoris of Dampe and Takkalage Singho Appu of Dampe; is well known to Police Vidanes of Dampe and Madaluwa and D. E. Perera of Madaluwa estate in Madaluwa. The Police Magistrate of Avisawella has issued warrant No. 982 for his arrest.

BODADENIYA RANTILAKAGEDERA RATTARANA; charged with theft and attempt to cause hurt with a knife on July 9, 1907, at Rambukpitiya in Nawalapitiya; is a Sinhalese of the Duraya caste; religion, Buddhist; occupation, cultivator; age, 35 years; height, 5 ft. 6 in.; make, stout; complexion, black; mouth, large; teeth, regular; hair, tied in a knot; wears moustaches and full beard; has white spots (kel aera) in both the hands; birthplace, Amuhenagedara in Attabage; general residences, Kotmale, Mapanawatta, and Dehipahagoda in Kandy; haunts Attabage; wife Jayatu and four children living at Bodadeniya; brother, Deluntadamada Kehelhitiyawagedara Siritha of Kotmale; is well known to A. J. W. Marambe, Ratnabhatmaya of Uda Bulatgama, T. B. Arawwawala, Korala of Pasbage korale, and Kiri Menika Dura ya of Karahandungala. The Police Magistrate of Nawalapitiya has issued warrants Nos. 39,234 and 39,235 for his arrest.

RAMASAMY; charged with escaping from lawful custody on July 16, 1907, at Dikoya; is a Tamil of the Parayan caste; religion, Hindu; occupation, cooly; age, about 20 years; height, about 5 ft.; make, well built; complexion, dark brown; teeth, well set; eyes, black and small; hair, black and not long enough to tie into a kudumbi; moustaches, scanty; general residences, Rattegalla and Worawella; is well known to Police Constables No. 1,905 Meedin and No. 686 Coopasamy. The Police Magistrate of Hatton has issued warrant No. 4,885 for his arrest.
