### ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE SEPTEMBER.

### WESTERN PROVINCE.

### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: yala crops have been harvested. A fairly good maha crop is generally expected.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables was good and prices were reasonable, but fruit was scarce and The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not good. The crop for the month is reported at 8,949,701 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 60 a thousand.

Rainfall: the rainfall was abundant.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: the yala harvest was generally good, and a fairly good maha crop may be expected, provided the paddy plants are not damaged by the rain.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: with the exception of a few cases of malarial fever. dysentery, and chickenpox in some villages, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: maha cultivation is going on.

Dry rain: nil.

Other products: (a) there has been a fair supply of vegetables, but fruits are scarce; (b) flowering of coconuts fair; (c) crop for the month 2,356,247 nuts.

Price of staple products: (1) rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 per bushels; (2) coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 80 per thousand. Remarks on harvest prospects generally: no opinion can be expressed yet.

- 18. The portion of the premises hereby licensed used as a store shall be kept securely locked, and no one but an inspecting officer, the licensee, or person whose name has been endorsed on the license as a person employed on the premises hereby licensed shall have access to the store.
- 19. No other business or occupation but dealing in opium shall be carried on in the premises hereby licensed.
- 20. The opium on the premises hereby licensed shall be kept in unopened balls. Balls which have been cut, broken into, or opened in any way shall neither be received into or kept on these premises. The licensee shall keep in the premises hereby licensed and have available for use at all times a true set of scales, and the following standard avoirdupois weights:  $\frac{1}{4}$  oz.,  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz.

### 21. The licensee shall observe the rules hereinafter mentioned for keeping his books.
