MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, September 12, 1902.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated September 6, 1902.

Present:—Mr. A. S. Pagden, Chairman; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. D. W. H. Skrine; Dr. C. T. Griffin; Mr. Pestonjee Dinshaw Khan; Major A. W. de Wilton; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; Mr. H. A. Jayawardene; Dr. Solomon Fernando; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of August 8, 1902, having been printed, and copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of August 8, 1902, be confirmed.

1. The following extracts from Minutes of Standing Committees of August 15 and September 5, 1902, were laid before the Council:—

August 15, 1902.

- (5) Estimate for building a boundary wall to enclose the triangular plot of ground adjoining house No. 2, Hulftsdorn, Rs. 149.
The Committee approve the expenditure of a sum of Rs. 50 for the construction of a live fence and a door in the house. Work to go on. To be provided in Supplemental Budget.

Jayawardene and the mover to consider and report on what terms and conditions the Council will allow the application.

Boustead Brothers be granted, subject to their complying with the rules and regulations passed by the Council at its Meeting on August 8, 1902, and the conditions laid down by the Council's Electrical Adviser in his report No. 804 of September 10, 1902, and that Boustead Brothers be informed that the Council, by giving this concession, grants them no monopoly for laying electric mains in Colombo, and reserves to itself the right, should it see fit to do so, of amending the above-mentioned rules and regulations in such manner as may be found necessary to secure the safety of the public.

Mr. P. D. Khan seconded. Carried. Mr. C. Perera dissenting.

3. Application from Messrs. Boustead Brothers for permission to erect overhead services to supply power to cranes in the harbour premises, was laid before the Council.

The Chairman moved,—That permission be granted subject to the conditions laid down in paragraph 10 of the Electrical Adviser's report No. 803 of September 10, 1902, excluding (h) of the said paragraph 10, and according to rules and regulations referred to in (g) thereof.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried. Messrs. Arthur Alvis, H. A. Jayawardene, C. P. Dias, R. H. Morgan, and C. Perera dissenting.

4. Letter dated August 15, 1902, from Dr. Allan Perry, Principal Civil Medical Officer, submitting the name of Dr. W. Marshall Philip for the post of Sanitary Officer, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Chairman moved,—That the Council do confirm Dr. Perry's selection and authorize the Chairman to cable the decision to Dr. Perry's address and to cable the money necessary for the passage of the Medical Officer, and that the agreement forwarded by Dr. Perry be referred to the Council's lawyers to ascertain whether any other agreement should be entered into by Dr. Marshall Philip on his arrival here, and further that the Chairman be authorized to pay Messrs. Fladgate their fees for drawing the agreement.

Dr. C. T. Griffin seconded.—Carried.

5. Letter from Mr. J. S. Driberg protesting against the acquisition of Quarry House was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Chairman moved,—That Mr. Driberg be informed that the Council cannot reconsider its decision, unless he is able to indicate to the Council a quarry which can be acquired by the Council, and which will not cause the metal to reach a prohibitive cost.

Dr. C. T. Griffin seconded.

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene moved as an amendment,—That the matter be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Mr. R. H. Morgan, Mr. James Pieris, and Dr. Solomon Fernando,—three to form a quorum,—and that the Government Agent be asked to suspend the acquisition of the property pending further communication from the Council.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.

The Chairman thereupon with the permission of Council withdrew the motion in favour of Mr. Jayawardene's motion which was carried.

6. Papers regarding the question of obtaining the services of the Government Electrical Engineer were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Chairman moved,—That the proposal of Government be accepted.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

The Chairman intimated that no reply has been received from Government.

The Chairman moved,—That the Council do assent to the proposal of the General Manager, subject to Boustead Brothers' consent, and agree to accept the rental of one rupee a year from the Railway authorities.

9. Application from Mr. S. W. Dassanaikie, Assistant Municipal Engineer, for increase of salary, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. Arthur Alvis moved,—That the salary of Mr. S. W. Dassanaikie, Assistant Municipal Engineer, be raised to Rs. 4,000 per annum, with further biennial increments of Rs. 500 until Rs. 5,000 is reached.

Mr. James Pieris seconded.—Carried.

10. Question of rate of commencing salary of the new Inspectors, Kollupitiya and St. Sebastian, also salary of the Supervisor, Vehicles and Animals Department.

The Chairman moved,—That Mr. A. Weinman's salary as supervisor, Vehicles and Animals Department, be fixed at Rs. 600 per annum, and that the salaries of the new Inspectors of Kollupitiya and St. Sebastian Wards be fixed at Rs. 900 per annum and house allowance of Rs. 300 each on condition that they live in their wards.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

11. Papers regarding the Colombo lake with Chairman's memorandum dated September 5, 1902, were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved.—That the Chairman's memorandum of September 5, 1902, be adopted.

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene seconded.—Carried.

12. To obtain authority of Council to waive costs on arrears of dog tax recovered for 1900 (*vide* Auditor General's remark No. 695 on revenue accounts for November, 1901).

13. To obtain authority of Council to strike off a sum of Rs. 250, being tax on vehicles and animal tax due for first half-year of 1901 in Kotahena North Ward.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved,—That Council do grant the necessary authority to waive the costs and strike off the items.

Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen seconded.—Carried.

14. Papers regarding a cadjan kitchen at No. 2, Elie House road, were laid on the table.

SIR,—I HAVE the honour to request that the Chairman of the Municipal Council be notified that the portion of land at Grandpass (consisting of the approach to the old bridge-of-boats and the garden adjoining belonging to the house now occupied and rented out to Mudaliyar J. G. G. Abeyesinghe) is required by the Public Works Department for the purposes of stacking pipes before transporting them by boat to Hanwella for the duplication of the main.

2. This land is now sub-let to this Department until the end of this year by the Mudaliyar, who has obtained the lease of the land until the end of 1902, and there is no clause in his agreement permitting Government to take over the land before the completion of the term of lease.

3. It is very desirable that the land above-mentioned should be let out in 1903 to this Department by the Municipality, and the Chairman be notified in time to prevent the tenders for next year's lease being accepted.
