MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, October 10, 1902.

The Council met this day at 3 P. M., pursuant to notice dated October 4, 1902.

Present :--Mr. A. S. Pagden, Chairman; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G.; Mr. Pestonjee Dinshaw Khan; Major A. W. de Wilton; Mr. F. H. Grinlinton; Mr. W. Shakspeare; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Pieris; Mr. H. A. Jayewardene; and Dr. Solomon Fernando.

The Minutes of September 12, 1902, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Mr. H. A. Jayewardene moved—That the Minutes connected with resolution No. 3 be corrected by the addition of the words "Messrs. Arthur Alvis, H. A. Jayewardene, C. P. Dias, and R. H. Morgan dissenting, as well as Mr. C. Perera."

Mr. Arthur Alvis seconded.—Carried.

1. Pursuant to notice, the Chairman moved—That the names of Mr. P. D. Khan and Mr. W. Shakspeare be included in the Special Committees on which Messrs. D. W. H. Skrine and the Hon. Mr. Giles F. Walker served.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

2. Pursuant to notice, the Chairman moved-That the Sanitary Officer make an experiment as to the practicability of dealing with the contents of the night soil buckets bacteriologically, and that the Council authorize the immediate construction of such experimental tanks and other appliances as the Chairman considers necessary for this purpose.

The Hon: Mr. F. A. Cooper seconded.-Carried.

3. Pursuant to notice, Mr. Arthur Alvis moved—That this Council do present to His Excellency the Governor an address on his return to the Colony, and with the permission of Council amended it by the addition of the following paragraph :--

"And the necessary funds for the address and for a contribution towards a suitable reception be provided by the Council, and that a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. James Peiris, Mr. H. A. Jayewardene, and the mover be appointed to draft the address-three to form a quorum.

The motion as amended was seconded by Mr. C. Perera and carried.

Mr. R. H. Morgan moved—That the matter be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Mr. F. H. Grinlinton, Mr. P. D. Khau, Mr. R. H. Morgan, and Mr. H. A. Jayawardene -three to form a quorum.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.-Carried.

9. Application from the Inspector of Private Buildings for increase of salary was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. Arthur Alvis moved-That the salary of the Inspector of Private Buildings be raised by Rs. 500 from. January 1, 1903.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall, Kandy, on Saturday, July 19, 1902, at 8.30 o'clock a.m., in accordance with

Notice dated July 15, 1902.

Present:-Hon. Mr. H. Wace, Chairman; E. Beven, Esq.; W. D. Gibbon, Esq.; C. Vanderwall, Esq.; R. W. Jonklaas, Esq.; Dr. J. Craib, Esq.; P. T. Habeeboo Lebbe, Esq.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on June 21, 1902, were read, confirmed, and signed by the Chairman.

2. The following documents were submitted :--Statements of Receipts and Expenditure from close of 1901 to June 30, 1902, on account of the Municipal Fund, comprising the (Nc. 1) General Revenue, (No. 2) Consolidated Rate (Police and Lighting), and (No. 3) Water-rate Account; Progress Report of Works done brought up to the

same date ; Health Officer's Report for, and Statement of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during, the month of June, 1902.

Resolved—That the several statements, together with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, as required by section 90 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, No. 7 of 1887, and the Health Officer's report, be forwarded to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the Government Gazette.

The following papers were laid on the table :--(1) Reports by the several Inspectors on laundries inspected during June and register; (2) return of burials in the General Cemetery during six months ended June 30 last.

4. The following correspondence was submitted and read :-

- (a) Letter No. 22, dated June 25, 1902, from the Colonial Secretary, acknowledging receipt of parcel con-taining the address of congratulation from the Municipal Council to His Majesty the King, and stating that the address will be sent to Sir J. West Ridgeway for presentation.
- (b) Memorandum E No. 7, dated June 30, 1902, from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding memorandum No. 594, from the Attorney-General, on the water supply by-laws, with reply, which was approved of.
- (c) Letter No. 23, dated July 7, 1902, from the Colonial Secretary, stating that the Postmaster-General has been instructed to include for consideration in his estimates for next year the cost of erecting three additional pillar-boxes and salaries of additional postmen and cost of establishing a Post Office at Katugastota.

5. Reports by Inspectors of districts on the insanitary condition of cesspits on following premises were submitted :

- No. 161, Trincomalee street, owned by S. C. Ahamado Ally; No. 165, Trincomalee street, owned by Seeru Ahamado Ally; No. 233, Trincomalee street, owned by Sinna Tamby Muhandiram—

with recommendation of the Health Officer that the cesspits be closed and dry-earth closets substituted.

Resolved—That special authority be granted to the Chairman, in accordance with section 209 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, as amended by section 33 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1896, to require the owner of premises Nos. 165, 161, and 233, Trincomalee street, to empty, disinfect, and close the cesspits on the several premises, and to substitute dry-earth closets therefor.

6. The Chairman intimated that though no official intimation had been received as to what day the celebration of the Coronation would take place in Ceylon, it would presumably be early next month. He proposed that the illuminations and special perahera should take place at close of the usual August perahera on night of Thursday, August 21, and that the treat to school children be held on Friday, the 22nd. The meeting signified its approval of the resumption of expenditure for purposes of the illuminations, authorizing the Chairman to make the necessary arrangements.
