

## Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Galkotuwehena, situate in the village of Digalle Pallegama in the Bogoda korale of the Yatikinda division, in the Province of Uva, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
