1.—All Departmental Orders will in future be published in Part I. of the *Ceylon Police Gazette*, which should be filed separately from Part II., which will consist of the old "Hue and Cry."

2.—The Inspector-General's Circular Guard File is abolished.

Order No. 44.

Rules regarding Punishment of Members of the Force.

THE following instructions are circulated for information:—

Police form No. 79 will be used for reporting rewards as well as punishments, and the under-mentioned points must be attended to in filling up the form:—

- (1) Each slip must be numbered consecutively.
- (2) The name of the Police Station should be given after the Sergeant's or Constable's name.
- (3) The date of offence should be given in the charge, and in the case of a reward the date on which the reward was earned.
- (4) The word "Date" printed on the form should be read "Date of entry in Service Register," and should be amended accordingly.

NOTE.—Separate files must be kept for punishments and rewards.
