SEASON REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 1906.

NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.

KURUNEGALA DISTRICT.

Hiriyala hatpattu.—Paddy fields are being ploughed for yala harvest. Fine grain: chenas have been cleared for yala cultivation. Health of people: fair. There are few cases of measles and dysentery. Health of cattle: there are few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease.

Katugampola hatpattu.—Paddy: maha harvest reaped, crop being gathered; prospects not good. Fine grain chenas are being cleared for yala season; Prospects good. Health of people: there were few cases of dysentery, and fever prevailed to some extent. Health of cattle: hoof-and-mouth disease prevails in two villages. Rainfall: there were few showers of rain during the middle of the month.

Dewamedi hatpattu.—Paddy: ripening and reaping; crops very bad; many fields abandoned, prospects being bad owing to the unprecedented drought. Fine grain: crops reaped; bad crops; prospects bad; crops when young affected by drought. A few slight showers here and there only. Health of people: fairly good; fiver on the decrease, only ordinary ailments. Health of cattle: not good; pasture grounds dried up and

Fine grain

Vanni hatpattu.—Paddy partly reaped and partly reaping; prospects, favourable. Fine there are being prepared for sowing; no rain. Health of people and cattle: fair.

Wendawii hatpattu.—Paddy lands and chena lands were not sown during the month. There were plenty of whooping cough cases among the children. Condition of cattle were also bad for want of grass and water. There were no cases of cattle murrain.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 1906.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: preparations are being made for yala cultivation.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables and fruit was good and prices were reasonable. Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 3 to Rs. 5 a bushel; cocoanuts, Rs. 30 to Rs. 45 a thousand.

Rainfall: during the later part of the month there were a few showers of rain.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: the rain has somewhat facilitated preparations for the yala, and a good harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: with the exception of a few cases of fever, measles, chickenpox, and five cases of smallpox in some parts of the district, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the sowing of the yala cultivation was brought to a close during the month.

Health of population: chickenpox, measles, and fever prevailed in the district. Health of cattle: good.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall registered at Matale: 12.65 inches.

Paddy: yala fields could not be cultivated for want of rain, but preparations are being made now. Dry grain: yala fields could not be cultivated for want of rain, but preparations are being made now.

Tanks in Matale North are dry.

Health of people: fair; cases of chickenpox, fever, and sore-eyes occurred in nearly all the villages.
