ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 1906.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: sowing for yala was almost completed. The paddy plants in some fields have suffered to some extent by the recent severe drought.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables and fruit was good and prices were fair.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 3 to Rs. 5 a bushel; cocoanuts, Rs. 30 to Rs. 46 a thousand.

Rainfall: the rainfall was below the average.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a good yala harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: fever, in an epidemic form, has broken out in some parts of the district, chiefly in the villages bordering the Kelani-ganga, Attanagalla-oya, and Maha-oya. The matter has been reported to the Medical Department so that steps may be taken to distribute the necessary medicines promptly to the fever-stricken villagers. With the exception of a few cases of chickenpox, measles, dysentery, sore-eyes, and one case of smallpox in some villages, the health of the inhabitants was generally good otherwise.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy: Kotmale, no work on paddy fields: Uda Hewaheta and Walapane, maha harvest being reaped. Crop not good owing to excessive drought.

Dry grain: no work on chenas.

Rainfall: there were only a few showers of rain.

Health of population: chickenpox and fever prevailed in some villages.

Health of cattle: good.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall registered at Matale: 2.15 in.

Paddy: very few fields have been cultivated for the yala season and the others abandoned for want of water.

Dry grain: menderiya and kurakkan chenas in some villages of Matale South and North are in plant now.

Tanks in Matale North are dry.

Health of people: bad.

Health of cattle: good.

Prices: moderate.

NORTHERN PROVINCE.

MULLAITTIVU DISTRICT.

Weather: there was good rain in some parts of the district during the early part of the month, and some tanks collected sufficient water for sirupokam cultivation. The south-west monsoon has set in.

Crops: the threshing of kalapokam paddy continued. The tobacco crop has not been sold yet. In some places cultivation for sirupokam is going on.

General health: fair; fever and dysentery prevailed to some extent. Cattle were healthy.

Prices of staple articles of food: paddy, Rs. 2.50 per bushel; rice, Rs. 6 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.75 per bushel; ellu, Rs. 4 per bushel; kollu, Rs. 2.50 per bushel; payaru, Rs. 4 per bushel.

NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.

PUTTALAM DISTRICT.

Paddy: not sown for want of rain.

Fine grain: plants are young and growing well.

Price of staple products are as follows: rice, varies from Rs. 4.50 to Rs. 6 per bushel; paddy, varies from Re. 1.50 to Re. 1.75 per bushel; kurakkan, varies from Re. 1.25 to Re. 1.50 per bushel; cocoanuts, varies from Rs. 4.50 to Rs. 5 per 100.

Health: satisfactory; a few cases of dysentery and fever prevailed in Demala hatpattu.

Rainfall: 2.97 in.

CHILAW DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 8.34 in.

Pitigal Korale North—Paddy: preparations being made for yala cultivation. Tobacco: maha crop reaped. Fish: catch worth about Rs. 2,500. Health of people: fever still prevailing in some villages. Health of cattle: good.

Pitigal Korale Central—Paddy: fields being sown for yala, Fine grain: chenas being sown. Fish: catch worth about Rs. 875. Health of people: malarial fever prevailing to a great extent throughout the division. Health of cattle: good.

Pitigal Korale South—Paddy: fields being still sown for maha. Standing crop promising. Fruits and vegetables: amply available. Fish: season closed. Health of people: very unhealthy; fever, cough, and allied affections prevail to a great extent. The Medical Officers and other private practitioners have a very busy time. Health of cattle: good.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy: in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, and Kolonna korales maha cultivation is progressing; prospects are favourable. In Kukul korale maha crops are being reaped and threshed.

Cultivation for the yala crops has begun throughout the district, but most of the fields in Kadawata, Meda, and Atakalan korales were abandoned for want of rain. In Kuruwiti korale mutteha crops have been harvested.

Dry grain: in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, Atakalan, and Kukul korales el-padi cultivation is proceeding. Chena cultivation in Kadawata and Meda korales was abandoned for want of rain.

The health of the people is very unsatisfactory. In Kuruwiti, Nawadun, and Atakalan korales fever prevails to a great extent.

Cattle enjoy immunity from murrain.

The prices of food products are: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel; paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Re. 1.50 per bushel; amu, 50 cents to Re. 1 per bushel; meneri, 75 cents to Re. 1 per bushel; mun-eta, Rs. 4 to Rs. 4.50 per bushel; tana, 75 cents to Re. 1 per bushel; cocoanuts, Rs. 4 to Rs. 8 per 100; salt, 10 cents to 25 cents per measure.

KEGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy: fields have been sown for yala harvest; balawi sown in Three Korales is doing well. In Beligal korale some of the fields are being ploughed for maha.

Dry grain: chenas are being prepared for cultivation of hill paddy and kurakkan. In Galboda and Kinigoda korales some have already been sown.

Prices: paddy, Re. 1.50 per bushel; hill paddy, Re. 1.25 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 per bushel; amu, 75 cents per bushel.

Rainfall: Kegalla, 13.80 in.; Ruanwella, 18.04 in.

Cattle disease: nil.

Health of people: fever is prevalent throughout the district.
