Ceylon, West Coast-Colombo harbour-Shoal in approach.

The British Admiralty has given notice (No. 251 of 1906) of the existence of a rocky ridge, named Onagalla, in the approach to Colombo harbour, with a least depth of 33 fathoms over its northern end, situated in a position 2 9 10 miles N. 13° W. from the red light on the south-west arm of the Breakwater.

Approximate position on chart No. 813, lat. 7° 0' N., long. 79° 50' E.
This shoal, which extends about one mile in a S. 13° E. direction from the above head, is about 50 feet broad, and has four other heads with depths over them of from 4 to 4½ fathoms, with from 5 to 7 fathoms between them

To the eastward and westward of the ridge there are depths of from 7 to 8 fathoms, but the lead gives but slight warning of the approach to it.

China North-Manchuria-Pechili Strait-Kwang tung Peninsula-Port Arthur-Mines removed in approach.

With reference to Notice to Mariners No. 151, dated May 8, 1905, issued by this office, the British Admiralty has given further notice (No. 254 of 1906) that the mines in the approach to Port Arthur have been cleared away within an area contained between lines drawn in a southerly direction from points situated (1) in approximately lat. 38° 48′ N., long. 121° 25½′ E., and (2) in lat. 38° 43′ N., long. 121° 12′ E.; the southern limit being a line running in an east and west direction on the parallel of 38° 38' N. Vessels, however, must still exercise due caution, as solitary mines may still exist in this locality, though it is believed that the sweeping operations carried out have been effective.

The cautionary note respecting mines will, for the present, be retained on the charts until it is known that the whole of the coast in this locality is free from these dangers.
