FINAL ORDERS.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," admitting Lands to be Private Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Kaluwagahawila, situate in the village of Midigama in the Weligam korale of the Matara District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 2nd day of December, One thousand Nine hundred and Four, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Kaluwagahawila, situate in the village of Midigama in the Weligam korale of the Matara District, in the Southern Province, containing in extent 10 acres 3 roods and 34 perches, and shown as lots 16,480 and 16,481 in preliminary plan 6,268 and in the annexed certified tracing therefrom, was made to J. G. Fraser, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such lands would be deemed the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 2,091):

And whereas (1) Bolapage Sinno Appu of Midigama, (2) Bolapage Siyadoris of Midigama, (3) Bolapage Lokuhamy of Midigama, (4) Malalagamagama Samel Appu of Pussellawa in Gampola District, (5) Mahatantrige Hinniappu of Midigama, and (6) Kahandawedage Jonis Appu of Ahangama made claim thereto, and John George Fraser, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry into such claim, I, Howard Orme Fox, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, with the consent of His Excellency the Governor, do hereby admit the claim of the said claimants to the said lands, as more fully described herein below, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances.

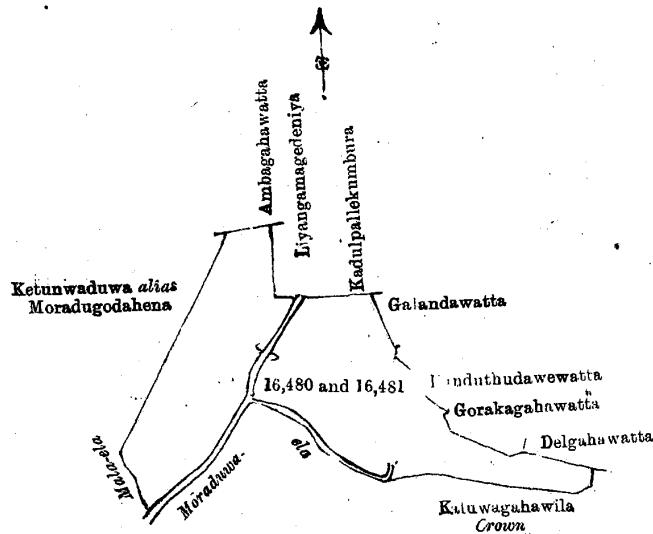
