Circular No. 89.

A T a meeting of the Committee of the Police Compassionate Fund held on the 28th August, 1906, the following amended rules of the Fund were decided on:—

Rule 5.—If there be no wife, unmarried children under eighteen years of age or the nearest relation or relations of a Constable totally and necessarily dependent on him may, in some cases, be recommended for the same donation as a wife.

Rule 6.—The grant for each child under eighteen years of age, whether the father's service has been long or short, shall be Rs. 5. ϵ
