
Description of the Land referred to.

FINAL ORDERS.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," admitting Land to be Private Property.

n the matter of the land commonly called or known as Thimbirigahawattehena, situate in the village of Kiulegedara in the Wellawaya korale of the Wellawaya division, in the Province of Uva, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on June 22, 1906, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Thimbirigahawattehena, situate in the village of Kiulegedara in the Wellawaya korale of the Wellawaya division, in the Province of Uva, containing in extent 6 acres and 32 perches, and shown as lot O 129 in preliminary plan No. 1,286 and in the annexed certified tracing therefrom, was made to the Government Agent of the Province of Uva within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such land would be deemed the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 2,489):


And whereas Samarasinha Lokuge Don Davit Appuhamy of Kiulealutgedara made claim thereto, and I, Herbert White, Government Agent of the Province of Uva, made due inquiry into such claim, I do hereby admit the claim of the said claimant to the said land, as more fully described herein below, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances.

Description of the Land referred to.

The land commonly called or known as Thimbirigahawattehena, situate in the village of Kiulegedera in the Wellawaya korale of the Wellawaya division, in the Province of Uva, containing in extent 6 acres and 32 perches, shown as lot O 129 in preliminary plan No. 1,286 and in the annexed certified tracing therefrom, and bounded as follows: on the north by Kalugalgodapatana belonging to Crown; on the east by the Indikadulle-ara; on the south by the reservation for the Kiule-ara; on the west by Kalugalgodapatana belonging to Crown.
