MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

To all Owners and Occupiers of Lands and Buildings adjoining Maradana road.

THEREAS under the provisions of section 160 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887 it has been determined by the Council, with the sanction of His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, to widen and improve the road leading from San Sebastian to Borella, known as the Maradana road, in accordance with a plan dated March 6, 1908, showing the new lines of frontage appointed for this street, and signed by the Chairman of the Municipal Council, Colombo (which plan may be seen at the Municipal Office during office hours on application to the Municipal Engineer).

It is hereby notified that, from and after the date hereof, all buildings which shall be erected, added to or altered in this street shall conform to the new frontage lines.

Every owner or occupier or other person intending to erect or re-erect, add to, or alter any building in the said street shall give notice in writing to the Chairman of the Municipal Council of his such intention as provided in section 176 and section 198 of the said Ordinance, and no such erection, re-erection, addition, or alteration will be permitted without the previous sanction of the Chairman thereto.

All persons intending to carry out any such building as aforewritten are invited to confer with the Chairman of the Municipal Council with a view to an amicable settlement of all questions as to the nature and extent of such building, and the compensation, if any, to be awarded to them in connection therewith.
