Inventory' Book.

THE attention of all officers is drawn to Government Circular No. 77 of 1907 regarding the Inventory Book. This should be carefully studied and obeyed.

2. Articles belonging to the Recreation Fund should not be entered in the Inventory Book, and if so entered should be struck off.

Date of Payment of Salaries.

OFFICERS are authorized to commence to pay their men three days before the last business day of each month.

2. Members of the Clerical Staff should, however, not be paid until the last day of the month.
