## ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

### SEASON REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 1906.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : yala crops have been harvested. A fairly good maha crop is generally expected.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : the supply of vegetables was good and prices were reasonable ; but fruit was scarce and dear.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6.50 a bushel ; cocoanuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 55 a thousand.

Rainfall : the rainfall was abundant.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : the yala harvest was generally good and a fairly good maha crop may be expected, provided the paddy plants are not damaged by the floods.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants : with the exception of a few cases of fever, measles, dysentery, and chickenpox in some parts of the district, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

##### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : maha cultivation is still going on. Heavy rains and consequent floods have interfered with the work.

Dry grain : nil.

Other products : supply of vegetables is limited ; fruits scarce.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; cocoanuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 60 per 1,000.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : fields already sown are likely to suffer from the floods.

Rainfall : mean, 86 in. ; total, 26.65 in.

Health of people : good.

Health of cattle : good.

#### CENTRAL PROVINCE.

##### KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha condition : the paddy fields in almost all the divisions are being transplanted, except in Tumpane and Uda Dumbara, in which they are being ploughed and sown respectively.

Yala condition : in Uda Dumbara and Pata Hewaheta paddy is being harvested, and in Udunuwara, Tumpane, and Harispattu fields are being ploughed and sown.

Crop or prospect of crop : too early to form an opinion.

Dry grain, maha condition : hill paddy in Uda Dumbara is being sown, in Udunuwara and Harispattu paddy in plants, and in Tumpane chenas are being weeded.

Yala condition : in Pata Hewaheta harvesting of kurakkan is over.

Health of people : not satisfactory ; chickenpox and dysentery prevailed in some villages in Udunuwara, and there were five deaths from acute diarrhoea at Mailapitiya in Pata Hewaheta.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices : paddy, Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 per bushel ; rice, Rs. 5 per bushel ; cocoanuts, Rs. 5 per 100.

## NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy : Kotmale, weeding continued ; Walapane, yala harvest reaped ; Uda Hewaheta, some fields are being harvested ; some paddy in ear.

Chenas : Walapane and Uda Hewaheta chenas are being sown with kurakkan and Indian corn.

Rainfall was in abundance.

Health of population : Uda Hewaheta and Walapane fever was prevalent.

Health of cattle : good.

## MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall registered at Matale : 22·79 in.

Paddy : maha fields are now in course of cultivation and in plant.

Dry grain : chenas are being sown.

Tanks in Matale North are now full.

Health of people : good.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices : high.
