Weudawili Hatpattu.—About 400 acres of paddy land and 40 acres of chena land were sown. There were heavy rains during the last part of the month, but no damages were done by it to crops or otherwise. The health of people was fair during the month and the condition of cattle good. There were six cases of hoof and mouth disease in Kudagelboda korale. The crops of land cultivated during the previous months are looking well.

Hiriyala Hatpattu.—Paddy: young plants; ploughing for balawi; prospects unfavourable on account of the drought. Fine grain: young plants and sowing; prospects unfavourable on account of drought. Rain at the latter end of the month. Health of people: fair. Health of cattle: good.

Katugampola Hatpattu.—Paddy: fields cultivated for maha; some still being sown; prospects favourable. Fine grain: some chenas are still being sown with kurakkan; some were sown about a week ago; prospects favourable. Health of people: fair. Health of cattle: fair. Heavy rains since 14th October.
