## ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1906.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: maha paddy plants are from 3 to 4 months old, and are thriving, with the exception of those submerged by the recent floods.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: vegetables and fruit were scarce and dear.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 65 a thousand.

Rainfall: the rainfall was abundant.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a fairly good maha crop may be expected, provided the paddy plants are not damaged by the floods.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: with the exception of a few cases of fever, chickenpox, and dysentery in some parts of the district, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

##### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: maha cultivation was seriously affected by the recent floods. In some places the plants were all destroyed, in others there has been only a partial damage.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: vegetables and fruits are scarce.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 9 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 45 to Rs. 80 per 1,000.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: it is doubtful that there will be a rich harvest.

Rainfall: total 20.58 in., mean .68 in.

Health of people: there have been a few cases of dysentery in all the korales. It is feared that malarial fever may break out in the localities which had been recently submerged.

Health of cattle: good.

#### CENTRAL PROVINCE.

##### KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha: in Udunuwara, Yatinuwara, and Pata Dumbara paddy is being transplanted; paddy in Uda Dumbara is being sown; in other divisions the plants are in good condition.

Yala: the paddy is being harvested in Tumpane and Uda Dumbara.

Prospects of crop: good.

Dry grain, maha: hill paddy plants in Udunuwara, Tumpane, and Uda Dumbara are blossoming; and in Pata Dumbara paddy is being weeded.

Yala: nil.

Rainfall: sufficient.

Health of people: good; there were a few cases of chickenpox and measles in Yatinuwara and Pata Dumbara.

Health of cattle: good, except a few cases of hoof disease in Uda Bulatgama.

Prices: paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.75 per bushel; rice, Rs. 5 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 5 per 100.

##### NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy: Kotmale, maha crop: plants 4 to 5 months old; a good crop is anticipated. Uda Hewaheta fields are being ploughed for maha. Walapane; no work on paddy fields.

Dry grain: Kotmale: no work on chenas. Uda Hewaheta and Walapane chenas have been sown with dry grain.

Rainfall: there was sufficient rain during the month.

Health of population: fever is still prevalent in Walapane.

Health of cattle: good.

Prices of food articles high.

##### MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall: registered at Matale, 12.57 in.

Paddy: maha cultivations of all the three divisions are now in progress.

Dry grain: maha chenas are being sown and in plant.

Tanks in Matale North are now full.

Health of people: good on the whole, a few cases of chickenpox and dysentery occurred here and there.

Health of cattle: good.

Prices: high.

## NORTHERN PROVINCE.

## JAFFNA DISTRICT.

Rainfall : 38·13 in.

Weather : wind from the south-west, south-east, north-east, and north-west.

Paddy cultivation : the prospects of the paddy crop is good.

Dry grain cultivation : varaku in crop ; kurakkan harvested.

Tobacco cultivation : nil.

Health of people : normal.

Health of cattle : satisfactory.

Prices of staple articles : paddy, Re. 1·87 per bushel ; rice, Rs. 5 per bushel ; chamy, Rs. 3·50 per bushel.

## MANNAR DISTRICT.

Weather : heavy rain has fallen throughout the district. 16·91 in. were registered at Mannar town.

Wind was variable.

Agriculture : the paddy cultivation has been considerably delayed by the continuous rainfall, which has to some extent also damaged the dry sowing. Tobacco gardens are being manured. The coconut trees, which were in a desperate plight, are showing signs of returning vitality.

Health of people : normal.

Health of cattle : satisfactory.

Prices of grain : rice, Rs. 5·25 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel ; coconut, Rs. 6 per 100

## MULLAITTIVU DISTRICT.

Weather : the north-east monsoon broke on the 11th November. Both before and after this date there were continuous heavy rains throughout the district. 16·75 in. was measured at Vavuniya. The fall in Mullaittivu and other places was considerably heavier, but unfortunately records were not kept. With a few exceptions, all the tanks are spilling, and several have breached. A large part of Mullaittivu town was flooded by a downpour on the 24th November. All the lagoons have burst their sand bars.

State of crops : a little damage was caused to the "manavari" lands by the floods, otherwise the prospects are very promising. The small crop sown in August under the tanks is doing well. Ploughing and sowing were going on under most tanks during the latter part of the month. Kurakkan in chenas is doing well.

Health of the people : fair ; fever and dysentery prevailed. Lack of good food, especially round Putukudiyiruppu, was probably responsible for a good many deaths.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices of staple articles of food : paddy, Rs. 2·50 per bushel ; rice, Rs. 6 per bushel ; kurakkan, Rs. 2·25 per bushel ; varaku, Re. 1·75 per bushel ; ellu, Rs. 4 per bushel ; kollu, Rs. 2·50 per bushel ; uluntu, Rs. 4·50 per bushel ; paiyaru, Rs. 4·50 per bushel.

## SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

## GALLE DISTRICT.

Paddy : the maha crops are thriving well.

Miscellaneous : the food supply of the people has been good, although the price of articles of food had risen high. Imported articles of food were available in any quantity at the different market places. Vegetable and fish were equal to the demand, but coconuts were scarce and dear.

Prices of staple food : rice, Rs. 12 to Rs. 12·50 per bag ; paddy, Rs. 2·25 per bushel ; fine grain, Rs. 2 per bushel.

Health : the health of the people in the district has been satisfactory, except for a few cases of dysentery.

Health of cattle : there has been no murrain.

Rainfall : 27·78.

## MATARA DISTRICT.

Weather : the weather during the month was wet.

Paddy : the maha crops are in good condition.

Prices of paddy : paddy, Rs. 2·25 per bushel ; kurakkan, Rs. 2 per bushel ; rice, Rs. 5·50 per bushel ; coconuts, between Rs. 50 to Rs. 55 per 1,000.

Health of people : the health of the people was not satisfactory. Fever and dysentery prevailed to some extent.

Health of cattle : good.

Coconuts : the prospects, judging from the flowers overladen with young nuts, are good for the next year. The actual crop for the month is not satisfactory.

## HAMBANTOTA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the cultivation of fields for maha has been completed.

Fine grain : the chenas under maha cultivation are doing well.

Weather : the usual maha rains have not yet commenced in Magam pattu. There were a few showers in the Giruwa pattus.

Health of people : the cholera epidemic, which was introduced into this district from Uva, has been stamped out ; there were about 25 cases, and several deaths from the disease.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices : country rice, Rs. 6 per bushel ; Coast rice, Rs. 6 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel ; kurakkan, Rs. 2 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 80 per 1,000.

Other products : coconuts do not grow in this district, except in West Giruwa pattu, and no report has yet been received from the Mudaliyar as to the actual crop of coconuts during the month.

Paddy : in Kuruwiti, Atakalan, and Nawadun korales maha crops are progressing well. Those in Kukul korale suffered damage by the floods, and their prospects are unfavourable. In Kadawata and Meda korales pera maha fields are being prepared for cultivation, and some have been sown ; prospects are not favourable owing to want of sufficient water. In Nawadun korale second maha fields are being prepared for sowing. In Atakalan and Kolonna korales yala crops have been gathered ; yield in the latter korale was not satisfactory.

Fine grain : in Kuruwiti korale el-wi crops are ripening ; in Nawadun and Atakalan korales they are half grown ; and in Kukul korale about a month old. Prospects are unfavourable in Atakalan korale owing to dry weather. In Kandawel and Tambagam pattus of Atakalan korale, in Kolonna, Kadawata, and Meda korales, kurakkan cultivation is progressing. Crops have suffered from drought in Kadawata and Meda korales, and some chenas have been abandoned for want of rain. Paddy crops on owiti in Kuruwiti korale are about to be reaped ; in Kukul korale they are about a month old ; in Kuruwiti korale some owiti have been sown with kurakkan and amu ; prospects are favourable.

The health of the people on the whole is generally satisfactory. In some parts of Atakalan, Kadawata, and Meda korales fever and dysentery are reported to be prevailing.
