DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:---

An Ordinance to prevent Thefts of Rubber.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make special provision to prevent thefts of rubber : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

Definitions.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Rubber Thefts Prevention Ordinance, 190."

2 In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears—

"Rubber plant" includes any of the following plants, namely---

(1) Hevea Brasiliensis (Para rubber).

(2) Manihot Glaziovii (Ceara rubber).

(3) Castilloa elastica.

(4) Ficus elastica (Rambong).

(5) Any rubber-producing plant which the Governor, by notification in the *Government Gazette*, may declare to be a rubber plant for the purposes of this Ordinance. PAGE
