MINUTE BY THE GOVERNOR.

T is with the deepest regret that the Governor announces the death of the Hon. Sir Alexander Ashmore, K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor and Colonial Secretary of this Colony, this afternoon at 5 p.m., after a short illness of five days' duration.

His Excellency desires that every public mark of respect be shown to the memory of the deceased Lieutenant-Governor, whose remains will be removed from Temple Trees, for interment in the General Cemetery, at 4.45 P.M. to-morrow, Saturday.

His Excellency the Governor desires it to be notified that, as a mark of respect to the memory of the late Hon. Sir Alexander Ashmore, all Public Offices will be closed at 12 noon to-morrow.
