### ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

#### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 1908.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: preparations are being made for yala cultivation. Sowing has begun in some villages.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables was good and prices were moderate, but fruit was rather scarce and dear. The flowering and prospects of coconuts appear to be slightly better than during the past two or three months. The crop for the month is reported at 9,747,315 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 30 to Rs. 40 a thousand.

Rainfall: the rainfall was plentiful.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a good yala harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: smallpox is still prevailing, though on a diminished scale, in some villages of Siyane Korale East, of Siyane Korale West, and of Alutkuru Korale South. The Medical Officers are still on duty. Malarial fever, measles, dysentery, and chickenpox are prevailing in several parts of the district. The health of the inhabitants was not good.
