ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 1908.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : cultivation for the yala season was over during the month.

Dry grain : nothing worth reporting.

Other products : (1) there was a fair supply of vegetables and fruits, but yams were scarce; (2) the flowering and prospects of coconuts were good, the crop for the month was 2,865,106 nuts; (3) the trees affected by the stem bleeding disease are being treated according to the instructions given by the Plant Pests Board.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconut, Rs. 32.50 to Rs. 50 per thousand.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : there is no harvest in the near future.

Rainfall at Kalutara : mean, 32 in.; total, 9.64 in.

Health of the people : not satisfactory. There were a few cases of enteric fever, chickenpox, and dysentery in the district.

Health of cattle : good, except for a few cases of rinderpest, which were reported during the month. The disease is now dying out.

SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

GALLE DISTRICT.

Paddy : the yala crops throughout the district are maturing.

Miscellaneous : the food supply of the people has been good. All imported articles of food were available throughout the district at moderate prices. Fish was scarce, but vegetables were equal to the demand.

Prices of staple food : rice, Rs. 12 to Rs. 15 per bag; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; fine grain, Rs. 2 per bushel.

Health of people : the health of the people in the district has been satisfactory, except for a few cases of chickenpox and dysentery.

Health of cattle : there has been no murrain.

Rainfall : 8.94 in.

Other products : the supply of coconuts during the month has been fair. Prices have been moderate. No change has been observed in the flowering of the trees.
