Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1908."


In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Boragollehena, situate in the village of Dehikinda, in the Passara korale of the Yatikinda division, in the Province of Uva, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

HEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on December 7, 1906, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Boragollehena, situate in the village of Dehikinda, in the Passara korale of the Yatikinda division, in the Province of Uva, containing in extent 2 roods and 6 perches, and shown as lot C 131 in preliminary plan No. 1,299, was made to Howard Orme Fox, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the sid notice, such land would be deemed the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown (with specified No. 2,630):

And whether (1) Boragollegedara Kirimenika and (2) Boragollegedara Hudi made claim thereto, and I, John George Plaser, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry
