FINAL ORDERS,

Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1908," declaring Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Buluhena, Buluhena or Dehigatahena, Walasgalahena, &c., Mawatahena, Kolonahena, &c., situate in the village of Narawelpita, in the Kanda-boda pattu of the Matara District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


