The Commander of H. M. S. *Waterwitch* reports (dated April, 1908), that he has located Scawfell shoal to be in—

Lat. 7° 17' 50" N.
Long. 106° 51' 18" E.

An examination revealed that it is a narrow ridge of coral formation, about 2½ miles long in an east and west direction and 4 cables wide in a north and south direction within the 20 fathom line; and 5½ cables long in an east and west direction, and 2½ cables wide in a north and south direction within the 10 fathom line.

A least depth of 5 fathoms coral was found nearly in the centre of the 10 fathom area. This shoal was not marked by any discolouration of the water, nor by overfalls or smooths.
