REPORTS. SEASON ABSTRACTS OF

AUGUST, 1908. SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: yala crops are ripening, and will be harvested next month; maha paddy has been sown; the plants are generally coming up fairly well.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : the supply of vegetables was good, and prices were reasonable, but fruit was scarce and dear. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were similar to last month's. The crop for the month is reported at 12,170,573 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 50 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 30 to Rs. 40 a thousand.

Rainfall : there were a few showers of rain during the first half of the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a good yala harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: with the exception of a few cases of malarial fever, measles, dysentery, chickenpox, and two cases of smallpox in some villages, the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the yala harvest is being reaped. The crop is not so satisfactory as it was last year.

Dry grain : nil.

Other products: (a) there is a fair supply of vegetables, but fruits are scarce; (b) the flowering and prospects of coconuts are fair ; (c) the crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 2,765,000 nuts.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4.25 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 30 to Rs. 60 per thousand nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a good crop cannot be expected.

Rainfall at Kalutara : total, 3.20 in. ; mean, 10 in.

Health of people: there were a few cases of dysentery, chickenpox, and contagious fever in the totamunes. There was also a case of smallpox imported into Pasdun Korale East, the victim being an immigrant Tamil cooly who had recently arrived from India. Successful measures were taken to prevent the spread of the disease.

Health of cattle : good.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Yala: hill paddy in crop. Dry Paddy, maha cultivation: ploughing and sowing in progress. grain : kurakkan in crop.

Rainfall : deficient.

Prospect of coconut crops: flowering fair. Estimated produce for the month of August, 1908: Tumpane 16,000, Harispattu 3,400, Uda Dumbara 1,500, Pata Hewaheta 70,500; in other divisions crop not ascertainable.

Prices of staple articles : paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel ; kurakkan, Ro. 1 50 per bushel ; rice, Rs. 5 50 per bushel ; salt, Rs. 3 per bushel ; coconut Rs. 6 per 100.

There were cases of chickenpox and measles in almost all the Health of people: not satisfactory. divisions, and several cases of smallpox at Harispattu, Udanuwara, and Yatinuwara.

Health of cattle : good.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall: '52 inch.

Paddy: cultivation of this is not satisfatory; this is due to the long drought.

Dry grain : chenas are being cleared.

Coconut: (a) flowering poor; (b) 139,857 nuts approximate crop for the month. Tanks in Matale north are dry.

Health of people : poor - Cases of fever, measles, chickenpox, sore-eyes, &c., occurred, also three cases of smallpox reported during the month.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices: high.

General health : satisfactory.

Health of cattle : good.

KURUNEGALA DISTRICT. [Report not received.]

PUTTALAM DISTRICT.

Paddy crop : ripening in some villages, and being reaped in others.

Dry grain : clearing for maha crop has commenced in the Demala hatpattu.

Rice : the price per bushel varied from Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 6.25.

Paddy: Re. 1.25 to Re. 1.50 per bushel.

Kurakkan : Re. 1 to Re. 1.25 per bushel. Health of people : fair, except in the Demala hatpattu, where fever and the usual parangi prevailed.

In many villages there is little or no decent water for drinking purposes. Health of cattle: the continued drought has affected the pasturage and water supply. Cattle are reported to be dying in the Puttalam pattu owing to this.

Condition of roads : fair. Repairs on some are progressing. Flowering and prospects of coconuts: the crop is affected by the continued drought, and the young trees are dying on a rather large scale in some places in Puttalam pattu. The stem bleeding disease is not spreading; it seems to be dying out. At this period in 1909 the crop of coconuts is likely to be very bad.

CHILAW DISTRICT.

Rainfall : 35 inch. Pitigal Korale North.-Paddy: bala-wi cultivation for yala has been damaged owing to drought. Preparation has been stopped for maha cultivation for want of rain.

Coconuts : about 299 trees flowered, and about 4,624,600 nuts gathered.

Tobacco: yala cultivation is in good condition.

Fish : catch worth about Rs. 1,683.

Health of people : there is enteric fever at Chilaw, and a few cases of measles at Karukkuwatawana. Health of cattle : good.

Pitigal Korale Central .-- Paddy: about 2,656 bushels have been sown in 29 villages for maha harvest. Paddy plants are dried up. A large extent of paddy lands have been abandoned for want of rain. 802 bushels have been sown for yala, and the plants are earing.

Coconuts : about 4,305,500 nuts gathered.

Fish: nil. Health of people : 199 cases of ordinary fever and 2 cases of measles have been reported.

Health of cattle : no sickness among cattle, but there is scarcity of pasture owing to drought.

Pitigal Korale South.-Paddy : about 400 bushels have been sown, and the sowing is nearly completed. Standing crop is dying for want of rain.

Coconuts : about 61 million nuts gathered.

Tobacco : plants are being pruned.

Hemp: hemp is being rooted.

Fruits are scarce.

Fish: nil.

Health of people : fair.

Health of cattle : is good, but there is scarcity of pasture owing to drought.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather : dry.

Rainfall : practically no rain has fallen this month round Anuradhapura. The registered rainfall at

Anuradhapura during the month is '04 inch. A little rain fell at Madawachchiya and in Tamankaduwa. Paddy : yala fields, are being reaped. The crops in the fields cultivated late are reaching maturity. Kurakkaa chenas have been cleared and set fire to. There are no tavalu (tank bed) or gingelly cultivation during the month during the month.

Other products : coconut trees flowered satisfactorily. The estimated crop gathered is 15,000 nuts. The pests of the red and black beetle and the stem bleeding disease of the coconut palm exist in the Province, but not to an alarming extent.

Health of people : satisfactory (except for 3 cases of enteric in Anuradhapura town) till end of month, when a case of smallpox was discovered at Nachchaduwa.

Health of cattle: satisfactory. The outbreak of rinderpest in the town of Anuradhapura has subsided now

WVillage tanks /: the village tanks are almost all empty now.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather : hot and dry, with a few occasional showers in Yatikinda division.

Paddy: the crop in Udukinda and Wellassa is reported to be good. The crop in the other divisions is not satisfactory.

Chenas: chenas are still being cleared.

Fruits and vegetables : scarce and dear.

Other products: (a) the flowering and prospects of coconuts are not satisfactory; (b) the crop for the month is about 74,665.

Health of people : satisfactory. Fever prevails in almost all the divisions.

Health of cattle : rinderpest of a virulent type broke out in Yatikinda and Udukinda. Nearly 100 head of cattle contracted the disease during the month. The epidemic has not spread to any of the other divisions so far, with the exception of one case in Wellassa.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the yala crops in some parts of the district are blossoming and ripening, and in some parts are being reaped and harvested; prospects are favourable except in Kolonna, Kadawata, and Meda korales, where crops have suffered from drought. In Kuruwiti, Nawadun, and Atakalan korales maha fields are being ploughed and sown. In Kadawata and Meda korales maha crops have been harvested, those which suffered from drought were parched up and were abandoned.

Fine grain: in Kuruwiti and Atakalan korales el-wi crops are young and about to blossom. In Nawadun korale second maha crops have been reaped, maha crops sown, and yala crops ripening; prospects are favourable. In Kukul korale harvesting of yala crops is nearly over. In Kolonna, Kadawata, and Meda korales kurakkan chenas are being cleared. In Atakalan korale kurakkan crops are young. In Kuruwiti korale owiti crops have been gathered, and some owitas have been sown.

Other products: coconuts, flowering prospects are fair. The crop is estimated in Kuruwiti korale at 25,000 nuts. In Nawadun and Atakalan korales there is no particular season for flowering, and the actual crop is not ascertainable. In Kolonna korale flowering is thwarted owing to drought. The crop is estimated at 370 nuts. In Kadawata and Meda korales coconut crops are unsatisfactory. The nuts are dropping from trees before being matured owing to drought, and the harvest during the month is very small. In Kukul korale flowering prospects are good, the crop is estimated at 700 nuts.

The health of the people generally is satisfactory. Chickenpox, fever, and dysentery prevailed in some parts.

Murrain among cattle prevailed along cart road in Kuruwiti korale. In other parts of the district cattle enjoy immunity from disease. Owing to the drought food and water for cattle are scarce in Kadawata and Meda korales.

The prices of food products are rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 8 50 per bushel; paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2 25 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Rs. 2 per bushel; amu, 75 cents to Re. 1 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 3 to Rs. 10 per 100 nuts; salt, 10 cents to 25 cents per measure.

KEGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy : maha fields are being sown. Yala prospects are good.

Dry grain: chenas have been sown with hill paddy and kurakkan; prospects are bad owing to the drought.

Prices : paddy, Re. 1 50 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; hill paddy, Re. 1 25 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. I per bushel ; amu, 75 cents per bushel.
