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FINAL ORDERS.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Liyana-achchigewewa, Kituleyaya, Kalagahena, &c., Kituleyaya and Ginigalpalehena (reservation for the oya), &c., situate in the village of Pahalaobada, in the West Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on September 14, 1906, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Liyana-achchigewewa, Kituleyaya, Kalagahena, &c., Kituleyaya and Ginigalpalehena (reservation for the oya), &c., situate in the village of Pahalaobada, in the Giruwa Pattu West of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, containing in extent 629 acres 3 roods and 22 perches, and shown as lots 9, 16, 17, 19, 23, 24, 25, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 1, 1a, 3, 4, and 10 in preliminary plan No. 384 and in the annexed certified tracings therefrom, was made to Walter Ernest Wait, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such lands would be deemed the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 2,553):

And whereas (1) Don Hendrick Gunasekara Wellappuli of Ittedemelia, (2) Don Saundiris Gunasekara Wellappuli of Ittedemelia, (3) Hakmana Dhamnananda Unnanse of Udapelegoda, (4) Galagama Mudalige Don Cornelis Appuhamy of Kongala, (5) Kendala Sunanda Terunnanse of Pusparama Vihare in Talahaganwaduwa made claim thereto; and whereas the said 3rd, 4th, and 5th claimants have withdrawn their claims to the said lands; and whereas the said 1st and 2nd claimants having been duly called upon by me by a notice in writing, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, duly served upon them to produce before me the evidence and documents upon which they might rely in proof of their claims, did not so appear or produce such evidence and documents; I, Walter Ernest Wait, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 4 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on July 30, 1908, order and declare under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, that the said lands, as more fully described herein below, are the property of the Crown.

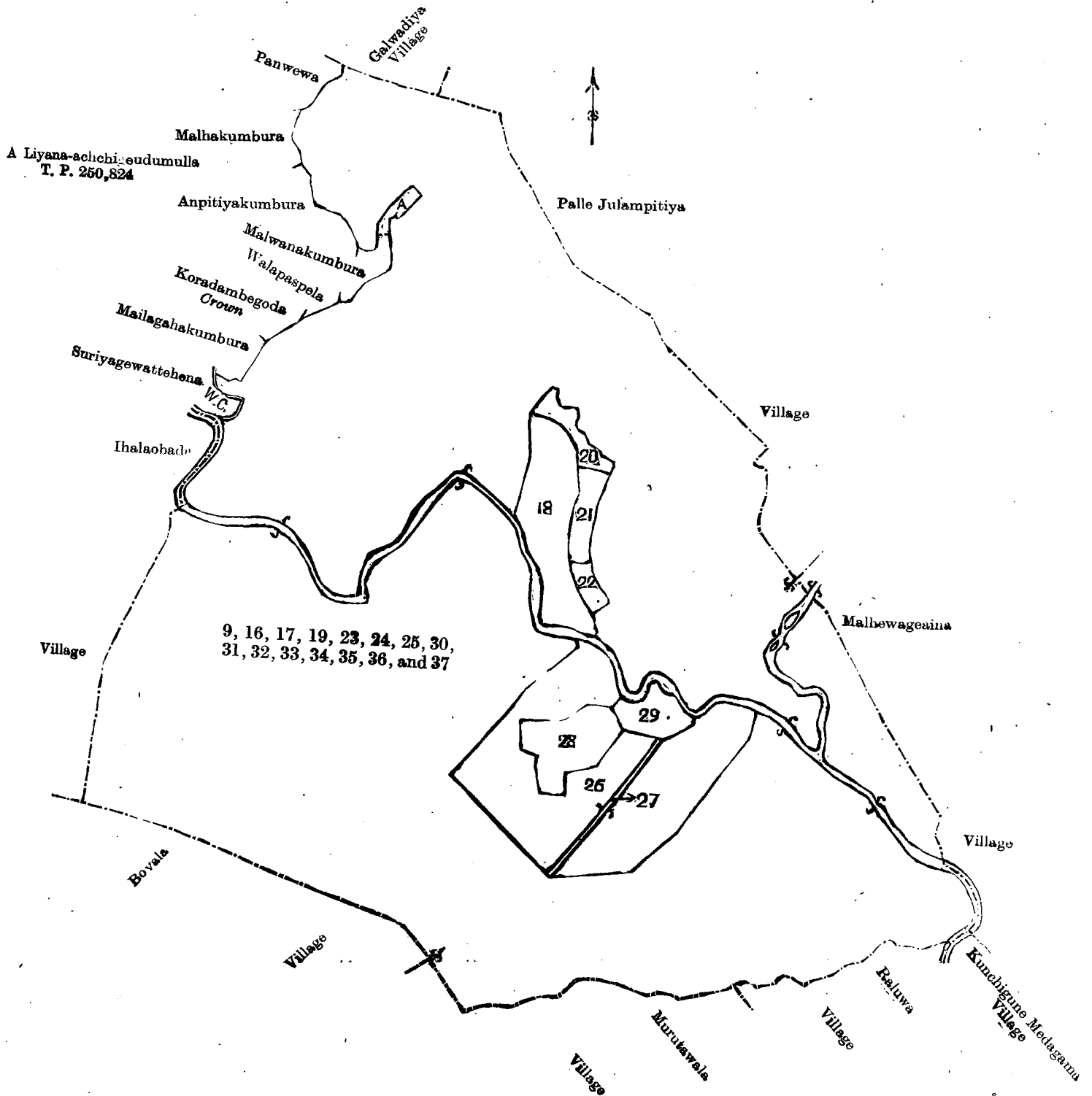

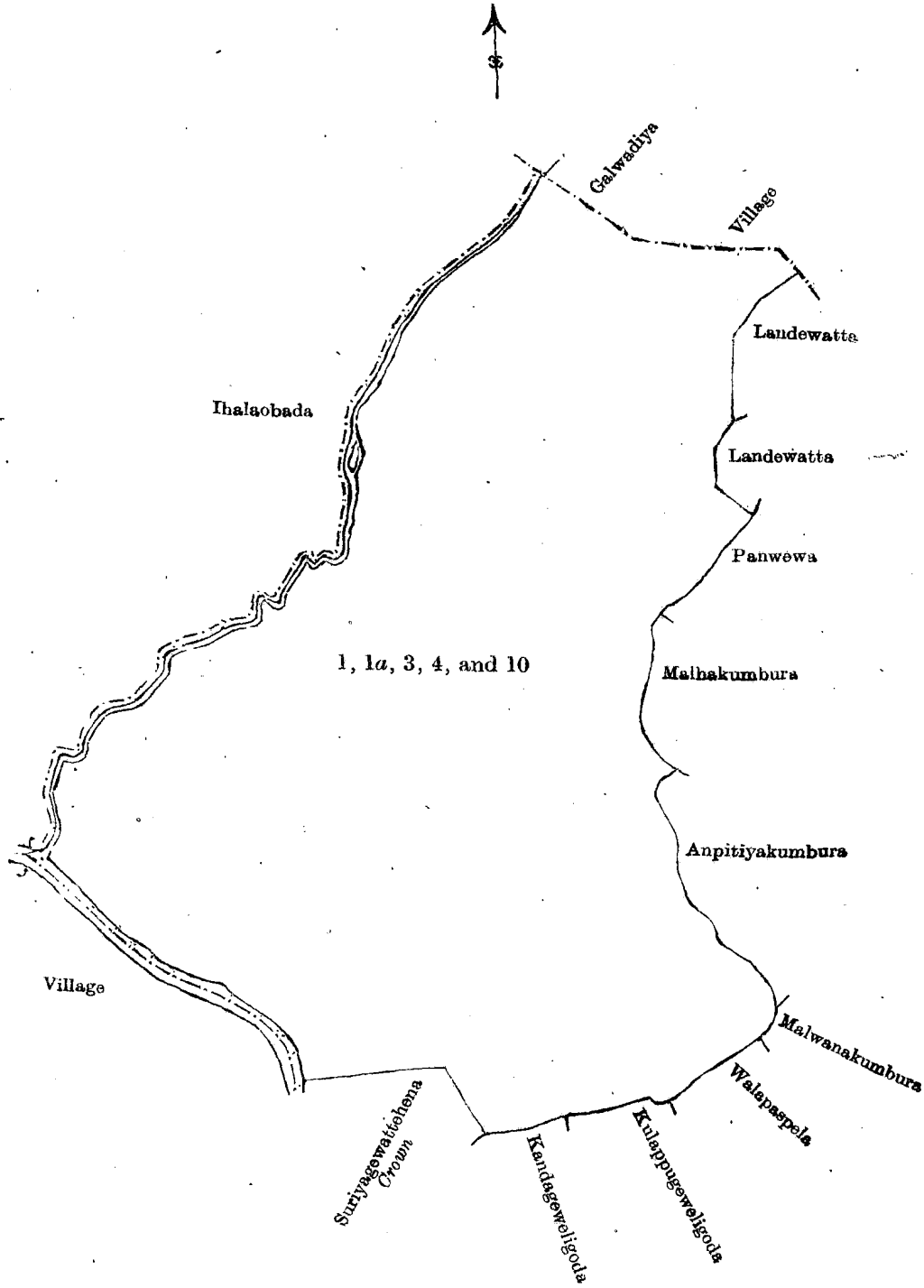

declaring Land to be Crown Property.**

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Vilpattu Game Sanctuary, situate in the Wilachchiya tulana and Moragolla Kadawat tulana of the Wilachchiya korale of the Nuwaragampalata of the Nuwarakalawiya district, in the North-Central Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

THE notice required by section 1 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," having been duly published in manner prescribed by that section in respect of the above-named land (*vide* Notice No. 3,042), and no claim having been made to the said land or to any interest therein within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, I, John George Fraser, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 2 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on August 14, 1908, order and declare that the said land, as more fully described herein below, situate in the Wilachchiya tulana and Moragolla Kadawat tulana of the Wilachchiya korale of the Nuwaragampalata of the Nuwarakalawiya district, in the North-Central Province, and shown as lot 1 in topographical preliminary plan No. 1 and in the annexed certified tracing therefrom, and containing in extent 88,880 acres, is the property of the Crown.

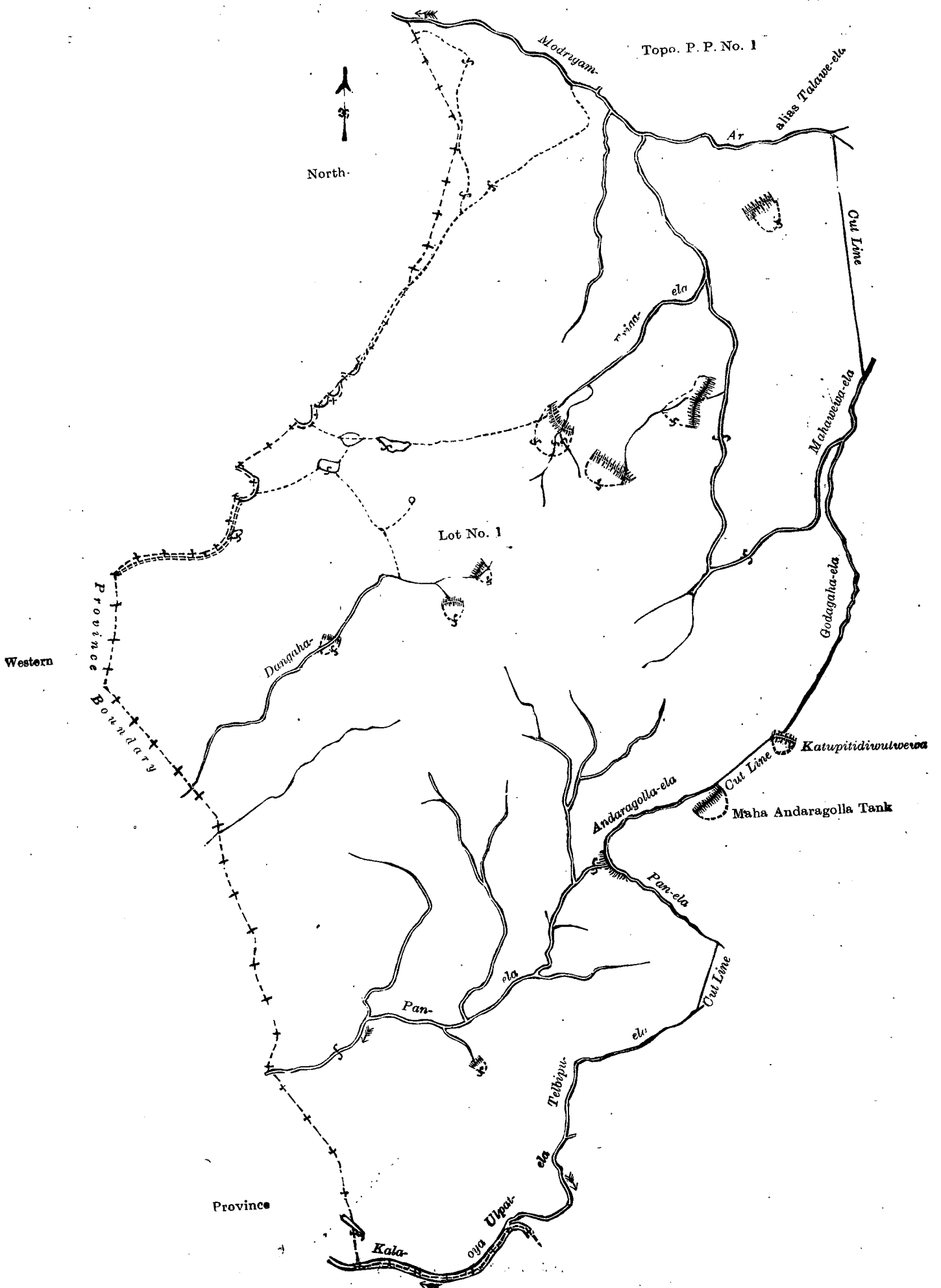

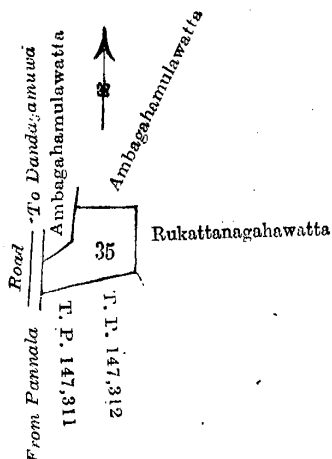
