ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 1908.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: yala crops have been harvested. A fairly good maha crop is generally expected.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables was good, and prices were reasonable; but fruit was scarce and dear. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not good. The crop for the month is reported at 7,854,832 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 30 to Rs. 40 per thousand.

Rainfall: the rainfall was sufficient during the latter part of the month.*

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: the yala harvest was generally good, and a fairly good maha

crop may be expected, provided the paddy plants are not damaged by the rain.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: with the exception of a few cases of malarial fever, Observations on the health of the inhabitants: with the exception of a few cases of increasing level, typhoid fever, measles, dysentery, and several cases of chickenpox and of smallpox in some villages, the health of the inhabitants was otherwise generally good. The majority of the smallpox cases occurred in the vicinity of Colombo and at Padukka.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha cultivation continued during the month. Experiments in transplanting paddy were carried on at several places in Rayigam korale under the supervision of an Agricultural Instructor.

Dry grain: no dry grain cultivation at present in the district.

Other products: (a) there was a fair supply of vegetables, sweet potatoes, and cassava bulbs. The supply of fruits was limited. (b) The flowering and prospects of coconuts were good. The crop for the month is estimated at 2,801,290 nuts.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 6 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 30 to Rs. 60 per thousand.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: nothing can be said at present of the coming harvest.

Rainfall at Kalutara: total, 13:42 in.; mean :43 in.

Health of people: there were two cases of smallpox, one at Walana in Panadure totamune and the other on Rayigam estate at Ingiriya. The patient at Walana, who contracted the disease at Padiyapelella in Kandy District, succumbed to the disease, and three of the contacts have since developed smallpox. Measures are being taken to arrest the spread of the disease.

The patient on Rayigam estate, who appears to have caught the the contagion at Padukka, has recovered.

Besides these cases of smallpox, there were some cases of chickenpox, dysentery, and fever reported from totamunes and Rayigam korale.

Health of cattle: rinderpest prevailed in the totamunes and Rayigam korale during the month. Walana in Panadurebadda, where the disease spread to a serious extent, was proclaimed an infected area under the

Ordinance.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha: the paddy in almost all the divisions is being transplanted, except in Tumpane and Pata Dumbara, in which the fields are being ploughed. Yala: harvesting is over. Prospect of crop: good.

Dry grain, maha: hill paddy is being sown. Yala: nil.

Rainfall: sufficient.

Prospect of coconut crop: flowering good. Estimated produce for the month of October, 1908: Yatinuwara, 14,200; Tumpane, 19,000; Harispattu, 2,500; Pata Hewaheta, 72,600; in other divisions crop not ascertainable.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 150 per bushel; rice, Rs. 550 per bushel; salt, Rs. 3 per bushel; coconut, Rs. 6 per 100.

Health of people: there were a few cases of measles, chickenpox, and fever in almost all the divisions, and also a few cases of smallpox at Wattegama, Panwila, and Yatawara in Pata Dumbara.

Health of cattle: good.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 11.21 inches.

Paddy: maha fields are in course of cultivation.

Dry grain: chenas are being sown. Coconut: (a) flowering satisfactory; (b) 121,558 nuts approximate crop.

Tanks in Matale North are not full.

Health of people: fair. Cases of fever, measles, and sore-eyes occurred.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices: high.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy, yala cultivation: young plants.

Dry grain, chena: sowing has commenced.

Health of population: dysentery and fever are prevailing in Walapane, smallpox and chickenpox at Uda Hewaheta, and measles at Kotmale.

Health of cattle: good.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.75 per bushel; Indian corn, Re. 1.75 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 5.50 per bushel; rice (Coast), Rs. 6.75 per bushel.

NORTHERN PROVINCE.

Rainfall: 10.21 inches as registered at the Public Works Department Office, Jaffna.

NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.

KURUNEGALA DISTRICT.

Hiriyala Hatpattu.—Paddy: sowing and plants about 1 to 2 months old. Fine grain: plants about 1 to 3 months old. Prospects rather favourable, but cannot say yet definitely.

Health of cattle: good. A large number of cattle died on account of the last drought.

Health of people: fair. Fever is prevailing to a great extent.

Katugampola Hatpattu.—Maha chenas are being sown. Some chenas just finished sowing; prospects, fair.

Paddy: maha fields sown in the southern parts of the division, towards the north and north-east being sown; prospects fair.

Health of cattle: fair.

Health of people: fair. Two cases of measles in Nakkawatta village. There was sufficient rain during the second half of the month.

Prospects of coconut flowering: fair. Number of nuts plucked about 6,500,000.

Dambadeni Hatpattu.—Paddy: yet young; prospects good. Fine grain: young; prospects good. It rained eighteen days.

Health of people: measles and chickenpox prevail in some villages.

Health of cattle: satisfactory.

Weudawili Hatpattu.—A large extent of paddy land and about 20 acres of chena land were cultivated during the month. The weather was favourable for cultivation. There was heavy rain during the month. There were cases of fever and measles in the interior. Condition of cattle: good.

Wanni Hatpattu.-No noticeable operations have been started as yet, tanks not having filled. Kurakkan crops are thriving; prospects seem good. It rained twenty days.

Health of people: good.

Health of cattle: good, but large numbers have died due to recent heavy drought.

Dewamedi Hatpattu.—Paddy: hatili and hondarawala sown, young, fair, preparing for bala-wi; prospects fair.

Fine grain: young crops fairly, good; prospects fair. Rain: reasonable.

Flowering and prospects of coconut: flowering good; prospects fair. Crops, approximately, 287,000 nuts. Rain off and on, rather heavy showers.

Health of people: measles prevailing in several villages.

Health of cattle : fair.

PUTTALAM DISTRICT.

Paddy crop: cultivation for the maha season has commenced.

Dry grain: chenas are being sown.
Rice, from Rs. 5:50 to Rs. 6:25 per bushel; paddy, Re. 1:25 to Re. 1:50 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Re. 1.25 per bushel.

Health of people: good. Usual parangi prevailed in some parts of Demala hatpattu.

Condition of roads: main roads are in fair order, the minor roads are under repairs.

Flowering and prospects of coconut: the crop was less than the corresponding period last year owing to severe drought. Flowering prospects are better since the rain commenced.

Rainfall: 7.79 in.

CHILAW DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 8.43 in.

Pitigal Korale North.—Paddy: preparation is being made for cultivation of elankali for maha.

Tobacco: maha tobacco being cured.

Coconuts: about 322 trees flowered, and about 13,824,000 nuts gathered.

Fish: catch worth about Rs. 2,175.

Health of people: good. Measles and fever prevailed in some villages.

Health of cattle: satisfactory.

Pitigal Korale Central.—Paddy: about 5,434 bushels only have been sown in 46 villages for maha.

Fine grain: 15 bushels have been sown, and the crop is thriving well.

Coconuts: about 2,396,400 nuts gathered.

Tobacco: five acres of tobacco have been planted, and a fair crop has been harvested.

Sea fish: catch worth over Rs. 600.

Health of people: 226 cases of ordinary fever and 10 cases of measles have been reported.

Health of cattle: good, but there is still scarcity of pasture.

Pitigal Korale South.—Paddy: about 70 bushels have been sown.

Tobacco: curing has commenced.

Coconuts: about 4½ million nuts gathered.

Fish: fishing season has commenced. Health of cattle: good.

Health of people; fair.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather: wet.

Rainfall: the registered rainfall at Anuradhapura during the month was 16:29 inches. There was plenty of rain throughout the Province during the latter part of the month.

Cultivation.—Paddy: preparations are being made for maha cultivation.

Kurakkan chenas are being sown throughout the Province.

Tavalu (tank bed) chenas have young plants.

Other products: coconut trees flowered satisfactorily during the month. The estimated crop gathered

during the month is 16,000 nuts.

Health of people: fair. Smallpox has broken out in Anuradhapura town at the Bo-tree pansala, and one patient succumbed to it, and another is under treatment. The contacts have been segregated and kept under observation, and all precautions are being taken to check the spread of the disease. Measles and sore-eyes are reported to be prevalent in the Province.

Health of cattle: satisfactory.

Village tanks: the tanks are either full or three-quarters full.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather: generally wet.

Paddy: fields are being harvested in Wellawaya and Bintenna divisions. The crop of the fields of the former division is reported to be satisfactory. No satisfactory report has been received from Bintenna. The fields of the other divisions are being prepared for maha cultivation.

Chenas: the chenas are being sown.

Fruits: scarce and dear.

Vegetables: very scarce, except in Udukinda, where they are cheap and plentiful.

Other products: (a) the flowering of coconuts is fairly good; (b) estimated produce for the month: Wellassa 13,000, Buttala 6,050, Wiyaluwa 5,000, Yatikinda 3,791, Bintenna 1,570, Wellawaya 200.

Health of people: fair. Malarial fever prevailed throughout the Province. Dysentery, chickenpox, and measles have been reported from Udukinda. There were two cases of smallpox in Haputale town, one case proved fatal and the other recovered. All necessary precautions were taken to prevent the spread of the epidemic.

Health of cattle: rinderpest, which first broke out at Passara on August 18, 1908, is still raging, in spite of the precautions taken to stamp it out. The epidemic is now confined to Yatikinda, Udukinda, and Wellassa.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 to Re. 1.75 per bushel;

paddy, Re. 1.75 to Rs. 2 per bushel; coconuts. Rs. 6 to Rs. 10 per 100.

Village tanks: the tanks are half full.

Rainfall: 8:14 in., as registered at the observatory, Badulla.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy: in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, Atakalan, and Kukul korales maha crops have been sown, and are progressing favourably. In Nawadun, Atakalan, Kadawata, and Meda korales yala crops are reaped and harvested; outturn of Kadawata and Meda korales was unsatisfactory owing to the drought which prevailed in Kolonna korale. Yala harvest is over.

Dry grain: in Kuruwiti korale perayala harvest was gathered in. In Kuruwiti korale and Nawadun korale yala crops are maturing and some are being reaped. In Nawadun, Atakalan, Kolonna, Kadawata, Meda, and Kukul korales owitas have been sown, and prospects are favourable. In Meda and Pannil pattu of Atakalan korale kurakkan crops are being reaped, and in Tambagam pattu kurakkan crops are being sown.

Other products—coconuts: in Kuruwiti korale flowering prospects are favourable, the crop is estimated at 25,000 nuts. In Nawadun and Atakalan korales there is no particular season for flowering, and the actual crop is not ascertainable. In Kolonna korale flowering prospects are fair, the crop is estimated at 380 nuts. In Kadawata and Meda korales the coconut trees are looking fresher, and the crops gathered were fairly good. In Kukul korale flowering prospects are good, the crop is estimated at 650 nuts.

The health of the people generally is satisfactory. A few cases of chickenpox were reported from Panawenna in Nawadun korale.

Health of cattle is satisfactory, except in Kuruwiti korale, where rinderpest is now prevailing.

The prices of food products is as follows: rice, Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 7 per bushel: paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2.25 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Rs. 2.25 per bushel; amu, 75 cents to Re. 1 per bushel coconuts, Rs. 3 to Rs. 12 per 100 nuts; salt, 10 cents to 25 cents per measure.

KEGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy: maha prospects are good.

Dry grain: hill paddy, iringu, and amu prospects are good. Kurakkan chenas have been harvested. The yield is good.

Prices: paddy, Re. 1 50 to Rs. 2 per bushel; hill paddy, Re. 1 25 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 per bushel; amu. 75 cents per bushel.

Rainfall: Kegalla, 7.95 in.

Cattle disease: cattle murrain is still prevailing at Yatiyantota in Three Korales.

Health of people: a few cases of smallpox have been reported from Galapitamada in Three Korales. Other products: (a) the flowering and prospects of coconuts good: (b) the actual crop for the month 604,700 nuts.
