THE following rule made by the subdivisions of the Four Gravets, Weligam kóralé, Morawak kóralé, Gangaboda pattu, Wellaboda pattu, and Kandaboda pattu, in the Mátara District of the Southern Province, under the provisions of section 6 of the Village Communities Ordinance of 1889, has been approved by the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, and is hereby published for general information :—

### *Cattle Disease.*

Whenever in the opinion of the Mudaliyár of the pattu there is danger of diseased cattle coming in contact with healthy cattle in any village, it shall be lawful for each Mudaliyár to order that all the cattle in that village shall be kept within properly enclosed grounds until such time as in the Mudaliyár's opinion the danger shall have passed away; and any cattle owner, or cattle herder, or person in charge of cattle who shall neglect to comply with this order shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty rupees.

WHEREAS by the 10th section of the Ordinance No. 8 of 1866, intituled "An Ordinance to provide against the spread of Contagious Diseases in this Island," it is provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, from time to time to make such regulations or orders as may be necessary and expedient to prevent the introduction or spread of infectious diseases in the Colony :

And whereas a case of cholera is reported to have occurred in Vannarponne, in the District of Jaffna, whereby it has become necessary that precautionary measures should be taken for securing the public health of the District of Jaffna :

The following regulations made by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, in pursuance of the power and authority vested in him under and by virtue of the said Ordinance No. 8 of 1866, and in pursuance of every other power and authority vested in him in this behalf, are published for general information : and such regulations shall have effect and operation from the date hereof.

REGULATIONS made by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, in pursuance of the provisions of the 10th section of the Ordinance No. 8 of 1866, intituled "An Ordinance to provide against the spread of Contagious Diseases in this Island."

1. The following officers shall be deemed "authorized persons" under and for the purposes of carrying out these regulations within the District of Jaffna :—

- The Government Agent of the Province.
- The Police Magistrate.
- The Assistant Superintendent of Police.
- The Chairman of the Board of Health (if any), or, in his absence, the Secretary of the Board of Health (if any).
- Any Assistant Colonial Surgeon of the Province.

2. It shall be lawful for any authorized person to cause persons infected with cholera, smallpox, chickenpox, or other infectious or contagious disease in any house or place hereunder described to be removed to some public hospital or other place provided by Government :—

- (1) In any house or place in which goods are exposed for sale.
- (2) In any house or place of public resort.
- (3) In any building in which there are no means of isolating the patients from the other inmates, or in any building where the retention of the patient is likely to prove a source of danger to others.

Provided that it shall be competent for any such authorized person as aforesaid, in case the removal of any person so infected in any house or place in which goods are exposed for sale is objected to, and the house or place is not otherwise open to objection, to allow the patient to be retained, on condition, however, that the sale of goods shall not be carried on in such house or place during such time as any person shall remain so infected in such house or place.

Provided further, that it shall be lawful for any such authorized person as aforesaid to allow any patient to be removed to any locality which such patient or his or her friends may choose, and to which the Medical authorities of the town or place, if any, do not object, instead of to the public hospital or place provided by Government.

3. Except as provided by these regulations, and except as provided by the said Ordinance No. 8 of 1866, it shall not be lawful for any person to remove or assist in removing any person suffering from cholera, smallpox, chickenpox, or other infectious or contagious disease from the house or place in which such person shall be to any other house or place, without the sanction in writing of some duly authorized person.

4. It shall be lawful for any authorized person to prohibit the removal for interment of the corpses of persons who have died of any contagious disease along any particular thoroughfare, and to prescribe the thoroughfares leading to the place of interment along which such corpses shall be carried. Information of such prohibition shall be given by notice in writing under the hand of some authorized person, which shall be posted in two or more conspicuous places in the prohibited thoroughfare, and by publication in such other way as may be deemed necessary by such authorized person.

5. These regulations shall come into operation on this date, and shall continue in force until June 30, 1894, or to such other time as the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, shall extend the same.

### Regulations relating to the Purchase, Sale, and Custody of Ceylon Government Securities for Depositors in the Post Office Savings Bank.

#### I.—*Purchase of Government Securities.*

A *bonâ fide* depositor in the Post Office Savings Bank, whose account has been in existence for three months, may invest sums of not less than Rs. 50 in Ceylon Government Securities on making a written application to the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department, General Post Office, Colombo, to this effect in the prescribed form No. 2, accompanied by his Savings Bank book. The investment will be made at the current price of the stock.

Such a depositor may also, irrespective of the limits prescribed for deposits, purchase through the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department, Ceylon Government Securities not exceeding Rs. 1,000 in one year and Rs. 3,000 in all by tendering a similar application with the purchase money in cash to the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department.

*Charges.*—The Departmental fee recoverable on purchase will be 25 cents per Rs. 100 on the capital invested.

*Note 1.*—Government Securities can be purchased by the Secretary of a fund only in his own name and without reference to his official position.

*Note 2.*—Government Securities may be purchased in the name of a minor, but such securities may not be sold during the minority of the minor although the dividends may be paid to the minor or to his natural or legal guardian as they accrue.

*Note 3.*—Applications made by female depositors must be signed by the female depositors themselves irrespective of whether the accounts concerned were opened by the depositors themselves, or through their agents or husbands.

Should a female depositor be illiterate, her mark or seal must be affixed to the application in the presence of a witness, by whom it must be attested.

*Note 4.*—Fractions of a rupee will not be received as part of an investment.

#### II.—*Sale of Government Securities.*

A depositor in the Post Office Savings Bank may at any time apply through the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department, General Post Office, Colombo, for the sale of Ceylon Government Stock that he has purchased through the Post Office, whether held by himself or in the custody of the Postmaster-General.

Securities to be sold by the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department, must be endorsed in his favour.

#### III.—*Safe Custody of Government Securities.*

A depositor in the Post Office Savings Bank may tender the Ceylon Government Stock that has been purchased by him through the Post Office for safe custody by the Postmaster-General.

The amount of such securities must not exceed Rs. 1,000 in nominal value in any year or Rs. 3,000 in all. A receipt will be given in the prescribed form No. 9.

*Charges.*—The Departmental fee levied on sale of Government Stock on behalf of depositors will be 25 cents per Rs. 100 on the capital sold out.

IV.—*Delivery out of Custody.*

A depositor may also apply through the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department, for the delivery to him of Ceylon Government Securities that have been purchased by him through the Post Office, and have been retained at his request in the custody of the Postmaster-General, surrendering in every case his voucher therefor (Form No. 6).

The transaction will then be closed.

V.—*Note in Ledger to prevent Withdrawal.*

On an application for the purchase of Ceylon Government Stock being received from the depositor with his pass book, a note must be made at once in the ledger against the depositor's account in order to guard against the deposit being diminished below that amount before the transaction is completed.

VI.—*Additional Amount to complete Purchase.*

If the balance at credit of his account is not sufficient to cover the cost of purchase of Ceylon Government Stock, the additional amount required must be tendered by the purchaser in cash with the application for purchase, and the amount so tendered will be treated as an ordinary deposit.

The limit of Rs. 300 fixed as the maximum sum that can be deposited in one year is not applicable to amounts deposited under this rule to complete purchase of Ceylon Government Securities.

VII.—*Application to Purchase to be sent to Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department.*

The application, which must be in the prescribed form (No. 2), must be forwarded to the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department, with the depositor's book, and will be filed in his office for reference.

VIII.—*Ceylon Government Stock purchased for delivery to Depositors.*

If the Ceylon Government Stock Certificates purchased are to be delivered to the depositor, the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department, will send them with the bank book to the nearest Post Office, under registered cover, to be delivered to him. The value of the certificates must be made to appear as paid items in the deposit account. On delivery he must sign a receipt on form No. 7, which the Postmaster will forward to the Superintendent, Money Order Office, by return post.

A memorandum of the amount debited to his account to complete the purchase will accompany the certificate.

The amount so debited will be entered in the daily cash account and the ledger against the depositor's account in the same way as a withdrawal, except that the words "Purchase of Government Stock" will be noted against the entries.

IX.—*Ceylon Government Stock held by the Postmaster-General for Depositors.*

If the purchaser has requested in his application that the Ceylon Government Stock shall remain in the Postmaster-General's custody, the necessary entries will be made, and the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department, will, in returning the Savings Bank book, send a memorandum showing cost of purchase, and enclose a voucher for the Ceylon Government Stock held by the Postmaster-General in safe custody.

An entry will at once be made by the clerk in charge of the Register of Ceylon Government Securities of the Stock so retained in custody.

X.—*Ceylon Government Stock Certificates presented with Application for Sale.*

When an application in the prescribed form is received from a depositor for the sale of Ceylon Government Securities, the necessary entries should be made in the Register of Ceylon Government Securities. The Stock Certificates should be tendered with the application together with the depositor's bank book.

A receipt will be given to the applicant in the form No. 8.

On the sale being effected the amount realized, less the commission and charges, will be entered in the depositor's book and in the ledger, and the necessary entry will be made in the Register of Ceylon Government Securities. The deposit book will be handed to the depositor on his returning the receipts granted to him for the Stock Certificate. After the amount has been credited to the depositor's account, withdrawals will be made in the usual way by the depositor submitting a Savings Bank notice of withdrawal and the issue of a warrant for the amount required to be withdrawn in the ordinary course.

Proceeds of sale of Ceylon Government Securities will be credited to an account under the above rules without reference to the annual limit of Rs. 300; but if the limit is exceeded by the deposit, and the depositor does not wish to take payment of the whole proceeds of the sale, he should be required to at once withdraw at least the amount in excess of the limit. In other words, if a depositor wishes to leave the proceeds of the sale or any portion thereof in deposit in the bank, he may do so provided that the amount left in deposit can be accepted as an ordinary deposit to which the limit of Rs. 300 is applicable.

#### XI.—*Custody of Ceylon Government Securities.*

When a Savings Bank depositor wishes the Postmaster-General to take charge of Ceylon Government Stock purchased for such depositor by the Postmaster-General, he should apply to the Postmaster-General in the form No. 4.

A Postmaster, who is requested by a Savings Bank depositor to forward Government Stock Securities to the Postmaster-General, will grant a receipt for these securities in the form No. 9.

The Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department, will grant a receipt (form No. 8) for the securities to be handed to depositors.

#### XII.—*Application to be sent to Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department.*

When a depositor requires the Ceylon Government Stock Certificates held in safe custody by the Postmaster-General to be delivered to him, he will send an application in the form No. 3, endorsing the receipt he has obtained, and the Stock Certificates will thereupon be sent to the nearest Post Office to be delivered to him. On delivery he must sign a receipt on form No. 6 which the Postmaster will forward to the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department, by return post.

#### XIII.—*Interest on Ceylon Government Securities.*

When a Government Stock Certificate is held by a depositor he will recover the interest by presenting the Stock Certificate on the due date to the Treasurer.

When, however, the Stock Certificate has been transferred to the Postmaster-General for safe custody, the interest will be recovered by the Postmaster-General from the Treasurer and will be credited to the depositor's account.

For this purpose the depositor should forward his deposit book to the Superintendent, Money Order and Savings Bank Department.

*Japan—Kiusiu, West Coast—Amakusa Island—Sunken Rock in Hachiman Seto.*

With reference to Notice to Mariners No. 252, dated October 23, 1893, issued by this office, the British Admiralty has given further notice (No. 3 of 1894) that the position of the sunken rock Osone has recently been examined by Lieutenant K. Kodama, with the following result :—

Osone has a least depth of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  fathoms on it at low water, with 8 to 13 fathoms close around, and lies with Mato sima southern islet bearing S. S. E.  $\frac{1}{2}$  E. (S.  $32^{\circ}$  E.), distant  $5\frac{1}{2}$  cables; and Kamimate jima S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  W. (S.  $54^{\circ}$  W.).

Approximate position : lat.  $32^{\circ} 17' N.$ , long.  $130^{\circ} 10' 30'' E.$

Also, that a sunken rock has been found on the western side of Hachiman seto, northward of Miyano kawachi bay :—

This rock, which extends in an east and west direction for nearly a quarter of a mile, has a depth of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  fathom at low water near its eastern end and 2 fathoms at its western end, with 15 to 20 fathoms around.

From its eastern extreme Katsura jima summit bears S. E. (S.  $45^{\circ}$  E.), distant  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mile; and Sodzu saki N. E.  $\frac{1}{2}$  N. (N.  $37^{\circ}$  E.)

*South Pacific—Fiji Islands—Dangers near Viti Levu and Vanua Levu.*

Notice to Mariners No. 10 of 1894, issued by the British Admiralty, is re-published.

The following information, dated October 26, 1893, relating to dangers near Viti Levu and Vanua Levu, has been received from H.M.S. Rapid :—

1. The master of the steamer Fiona reports the existence of discoloured water, apparently a shoal, in Nandi waters, west coast of Viti Levu, lying with Curacoa rocks bearing N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  E. (N.  $48^{\circ}$  E.), distant  $1\frac{3}{8}$  mile; or approximately in lat.  $17^{\circ} 47\frac{1}{4}' S.$ , long.  $177^{\circ} 16\frac{1}{2}' E.$

Several patches of discoloured water were seen from the masthead of H.M.S. Rapid in this vicinity on October 14, 1893.

The two sand cays, bearing respectively from Curacoa rock N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  W. (N.  $53^{\circ}$  W.),  $1\frac{1}{4}$  mile, and W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  N. (N.  $85^{\circ}$  W.), 2 miles, are coral patches just awash.

2. Dongalooa reef, north coast of Viti Levu, extends nearly 5 miles further westward than shown on the chart; the western end of the reef lies with the eastern entrance to Ba river, bearing about S. by W. (S.  $11^{\circ}$  W.), or approximately in lat.  $17^{\circ} 24\frac{1}{2}' S.$ , long.  $177^{\circ} 40' E.$

There are a few mangrove bushes on the western end of the reef, and none on the eastern end.

3. A coral patch, with an estimated depth of 6 ft. on it, lies south-westward of Vanua Levu, in a position with Solevu peak bearing N. E. by E. (N.  $56^{\circ}$  E.), distant  $10\frac{1}{2}$  miles; and Solevu peak N. N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  W. (N.  $25^{\circ}$  W.), or approximately in lat.  $17^{\circ} 4' S.$ , long.  $178^{\circ} 36' E.$

## NOTICES UNDER THE FOREST ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS by the 6th section of Ordinance No. 10 of 1885 it is enacted that whenever it is proposed to constitute any land a reserved forest, notice thereof shall be published in the *Government Gazette*—

- (a) specifying, as nearly as possible, the situation and limits of such land ;
- (b) declaring that it is proposed to constitute such land a reserved forest ;
- (c) naming an officer (hereinafter called the "Forest Settlement Officer"), who shall be appointed by the Governor, to inquire into and determine the existence, nature, and extent of any rights claimed by, or alleged to exist in favour of, any person in or over any land comprised within such limits, and any claims relating to the practice within such limits of chena cultivation, and to deal with the same as provided in chapter II. of the said Ordinance :

And whereas it is proposed to constitute the lands referred to in the schedule hereto annexed a reserved forest : Notice is hereby given (1) that it is proposed to constitute the lands known as Fuel Reserve Forests, called Mirigankanda, Halugankanda, Datugalakanda, and Halpankanda, lying within the boundaries defined in the schedule hereto annexed, a reserved forest ; (2) that Mr. L. W. Booth is the officer appointed the Forest Settlement Officer in respect thereof :—

6. Sufficient sureties will be required to join in a bond for the due fulfilment of the contract. The amount of security is given opposite the name of the station. Title deeds or cash must be deposited. The person whose tender has been accepted by Government will be required to bear the expense of having security bonds prepared by the Attorney-General for the due performance of his contract.

7. In case any person makes any alterations in his tender before forwarding it to the Colonial Secretary, such alterations should invariably bear his initials; otherwise the tender will be treated as informal and rejected.

"(3) That the offer made by F. Dornhorst, Esq., and Dr. C. W. van Geyzel for the purchase of the assets, plant, book-debts, credits, and goodwill of the Company for the sum of Seven Thousand Rupees be, and the same is hereby accepted.

"(4) That the Liquidator be and he is hereby authorized to transfer and convey all the assets, plant, book-debts, credits, and goodwill of the Company to F. Dornhorst, Esq., and Dr. C. W. van Geyzel for the sum of Seven Thousand Rupees, and to execute all necessary deeds and assurances for these purposes.

"(5) That so much of the said sum of Seven Thousand Rupees as may be necessary be applied in payment of the debts of the Company, and the balance, if any, distributed rateably among the Shareholders."
