The examination in the Criminal Procedure Code prescribed under the Minute of March 26, 1900, for officers in the Fourth Class of the Civil Service, will also be held on April 20, 1909, as well as at the Kandy Kacheheri.

It is also hereby notified that candidates will be given the option of using Codes in the examination in the Criminal Procedure Code and the Penal Code; they must, however, state when sending in their names what their decision is, as the character of the papers set for those who use Codes and those who do not will be different.

The examination for officers in the Police Department, and the *vivâ voce* examination in the native languages for officers in the Public Works Department, the Irrigation Department, the Forest Department, and the Railway Department, will be held at the same time and place.

Candidates are required to send in their names not later than March 31, 1909.

Gentlemen in the Civil Service should state in their applications whether they are presenting themselves for the first or second examination, and whether they intend taking up Sinhalese or Tamil, and whether they wish to have the option of using Codes.

281 A. Where a public conveyance is available, the actual fare by such public conveyance may be claimed, whatsoever means of transport may be used, provided such means are reasonable.

For the purpose of these regulations, the railway and coaches, steamers, and boats regularly plying for hire are deemed to be public conveyances.

The table of coach services published in the issue of the "Post Office Guide" current at the time of the journey shall be taken to represent the lines of road on which public conveyances are available.

281 B. Where no public conveyance is available, all Volunteer Officers may claim mileage allowance at 37½ cents per mile to cover the cost of private or hired transport, but not more than Rs. 10 will be allowed for mileage in any one day.

Note.—(1) When the journey is performed on foot or by bicycle (ordinary or motor), half the above rates only may be claimed.

(2) When the journey is performed by private or hired motor car, Volunteer Officers may claim 60 cents per mile, with a maximum daily allowance of Rs. 45 (i.e., for a distance of 75 miles).

(a) At the rate of 20 cents per truck per mile between Mankulam or Vavuniya and Kurunegala.

(b) At the rate of 25 cents per truck per mile from Kurunegala to Colombo.

A maximum number of 12 Sinhalese cattle may be loaded in an ordinary cattle wagon between Mankulam or Vavuniya and Colombo, provided no overcrowding is caused thereby.

ACCESSION OF LIBERIA TO BERNE COPYRIGHT CONVENTION AND ADDITIONAL ACT.

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, December 21, 1908.

Present :

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS on September 9, 1886, a Convention (hereinafter called the Berne Convention) with respect to the protection to be given by way of copyright to the authors of literary and artistic works was concluded between Her late Majesty Queen Victoria and the foreign countries following, that is to say:—Belgium, Hayti, Switzerland, France, Italy, Germany, Spain, and Tunis:

And whereas on September 5, 1887, the ratifications of the said Convention were duly exchanged between Her late Majesty Queen Victoria and the aforesaid countries:

And whereas by an Order in Council, dated November 28, 1887, and made under the authority committed to Her late Majesty Queen Victoria by the International Copyright Acts, 1844 to 1886, Her Majesty was pleased to make provision for giving rights of copyright throughout Her Majesty's dominions to the authors of literary and artistic works first produced in any of the said foreign countries (therein referred to as the foreign countries of the Copyright Union) and otherwise giving effect throughout Her Majesty's dominions to the terms of the said Berne Convention, and an English translation of the said Convention was set out in the first schedule to the said Order in Council:

And whereas since the date of the said Order in Council the foreign countries following, namely:—Luxemburg, Monaco, Montenegro, Norway, and Sweden have acceded to the said Berne Convention, and by Orders in Council dated respectively August 10, 1888, October 15, 1889, May 16, 1893, August 1, 1896, December 12, 1904, and made under the authority aforesaid, the provisions of the said Order in Council of November 28, 1887, have been extended to the last-mentioned foreign countries respectively:

And whereas an Additional Act to the said Berne Convention was agreed upon between Her late Majesty Queen Victoria and the following foreign countries for the purpose of varying the provisions of the said Berne Convention, namely:—Germany, Italy, Switzerland, Belgium, Luxemburg, Spain, Monaco, Tunis, France, and Montenegro, and the ratifications of the said Additional Act were, on September 9, 1897, exchanged between Her late Majesty Queen Victoria and the said foreign countries:

And whereas by an Order in Council, dated March 7, 1898, and made under the authority aforesaid, Her late Majesty Queen Victoria was pleased to make provision for varying the hereinbefore recited Order in Council of November 28, 1887, and otherwise giving effect to the said Additional Act throughout Her Majesty's dominions so far as regards the foreign countries hereinbefore named as parties to the said Additional Act, and an English translation of the said Additional Act is set forth in the schedule to the Order in Council now in recital:

And whereas the Republic of Hayti having duly acceded to the said Additional Act, the said Order in Council of March 7, 1898, was, by Order in Council of May 19, 1898, extended to the said Republic:

And whereas the Empire of Japan and the Kingdom of Denmark and the Faroe Islands, having duly acceded to the said Berne Convention and the said Additional Act, the said Orders in Council of November 28, 1887, and March 7, 1898, were, by Orders in Council dated respectively August 8, 1899, and October 9, 1903, extended to the said Empire of Japan and to the said Kingdom of Denmark and the Faroe Islands :

And whereas the Principality of Montenegro having duly denounced the said Berne Convention, the said Order in Council of May 16, 1893, was revoked by an Order in Council of August 8, 1899, and the provisions of the said Orders in Council of November 28, 1887, and March 7, 1898, have ceased to apply to the said Principality of Montenegro :

And whereas the foreign countries following, namely:—Luxemburg, Monaco, Norway, Japan, Denmark, and the Faroe Islands, and Sweden, together with the foreign countries comprised in the said Order in Council of November 28, 1887, now constitute the foreign countries of the Copyright Union within the meaning of the said Order in Council of the November 28, 1887 :

And whereas it has been intimated to His Majesty's Government that the Government of Liberia have notified the accession of that country to the said Berne Convention and the said Additional Act, such accession to take effect from October 16, 1908 :

And whereas His Majesty in Council is satisfied that the said Government of Liberia has made such provisions as it appears to His Majesty expedient to require for the protection of authors' works first produced in His Majesty's dominions :

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, and by virtue of the authority committed to His Majesty by the International Copyright Acts, 1844 to 1886, doth order, and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

- (1) From and after the commencement of this Order the hereinbefore recited Orders in Council of November 28, 1887, and March 7, 1898, shall extend to the Republic of Liberia.
- (2) This Order shall come into operation as from October 16, 1908, which date is hereinbefore referred to as the commencement of this Order.
- (3) And the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury are to give the necessary Orders herein accordingly.

VITAL STATISTICS.

Registrar-General's Weekly Health Report of the City of Colombo for the Week ended February 13, 1909.

Births.—The total births registered were 103 (4 Europeans, 9 Burghers, 56 Sinhalese, 15 Tamils, 15 Moors, 2 Malays, and 2 Others). The birth-rate per 1,000 per annum (calculated on the estimated population on January 1, 1909, viz., 182,058) was 29.5, as against 22.3 in the preceding week and 30.7 in the corresponding week of last year.

Deaths.—The total deaths registered were 149 (4 Europeans, 5 Burghers, 65 Sinhalese, 37 Tamils, 28 Moors, 6 Malays, and 4 Others), including 6 deaths of town residents who died in the Infectious Diseases Hospital at Kanatta. The death-rate per 1,000 per annum was 42.7, as against 43.0 in the previous week and 26.7 in the corresponding week of last year.

Infantile Deaths.—Of the 149 total deaths, 30 were of infants under one year of age, as against 27 in the preceding week and 25 in the corresponding week of the previous year.

Still Births.—The number of still births registered during the week was 7.

Selected Causes of Death.—Six deaths were registered in the town from *Diarrhoea* and 11 from *Dysentery*.

Ten deaths were registered from *Phthisis* (against 18 in the previous week), of which 3 were in St. Sebastian, 2 each in St. Paul's and Kollupitiya, 1 each in New Bazaar and Maradana Ward, and 1 in the General Hospital (a patient whose residence was not known). Six deaths were registered from *Bronchitis* and 21 from *Pneumonia*.

Eight deaths were registered from *Enteric Fever* (against 7 in the previous week and 7 and 8 in the two preceding weeks), of which 2 were in Slave Island, 2 in the General Hospital (of patients from outside the town), and 1 in each in Pettah, Kotahena, Maradana, and Kollupitiya. During the week 36 cases of Enteric Fever were reported, as against 26 in the previous week.

Seven deaths were registered from *Smallpox* in the Infectious Diseases Hospital at Kanatta, of which 6 were of Colombo Town residents (4 from Maradana and 1 each from Pettah and Kotahena), and the other from outside the town. The 6 former alone are here taken into account. During the week 12 cases of Smallpox were reported (the same number as in the previous week).

One death was registered in the town as due to *Measles*. During the week 17 cases of Measles were reported, as also 28 of Chickenpox.

State of the Weather.—The mean temperature of air was 81.5°, against 79.4° in the preceding week and 80.1° in the corresponding week of the previous year. The mean atmospheric pressure was 29.973 in., against 29.960 in. in the preceding week and 29.995 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year. The total rainfall in the week was 0.01 in., against nil in the preceding week and in the corresponding week of the previous year.
